PASTOR'S MESSAGE

This week we celebrate 'Divine Mercy Sunday'. Divine Mercy is understood from the confession of St. Thomas who proclaimed the Resurrection Faith: "My Lord and my God" (John 20:28) The Risen Christ is the Lord, as attested by St. Paul in his letter to Philippians 2:11. Every tongue should acclaim, "Jesus Christ as Lord, to the Glory of God the Father." Divine Mercy flows from the heart of Jesus who prayed, "Father forgive them for they know not what they are doing" (Lk 23:34) Pope Francis often said, 'The essence of the Gospel of Christ is Mercy'. "Be Merciful / Compassionate as your Heavenly Father is Compassionate/ Merciful". (Lk 6;36)

Shakespeare the playwright wrote, "The quality of mercy is not strained. It blesses the one who gives and blesses the one who receives." The Great Prophet Isaiah wrote: "As the rain and the snow come down from the heavens and do not return without watering the earth, making it yield and giving growth to provide seed for the sower and bread for eating, so the Word that goes from the mouth of God (It does not return to Him empty, without carrying out his will and achieving what it was sent to do); so, does mercy. (Is 55:10-11) Mercy reveals the very heart of God. Mercy is also known as compassion and, in the Beatitudes we read in Matthew 5:7: "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy."

Paul in his letter to Romans 3:21-26 discusses the Justice of God. Everyone, including the Jew and the Gentiles sinned and forfeited the glory of God. But God justified everyone through the free gift of

His grace by the death of Jesus Christ, so that we all could be reconciled in faith (this is the Justice of God). John wrote in 3:16: "God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him may have Eternal life. God did not send his Son to condemn the world, rather to save the world. (Divine Justice is too unfathomable) Jesus gave expression to the Mercy of God through his painful death on the Cross and redeemed the world from the punishment of sin and death.

Since we all believe in the mercy of God, we are invited to imitate Him in our human endeavors, such as forgiving and embracing our offenders and accusers. Welcoming those who humiliate and hurt us. We should become the vehicle of mercy in our activities. St. James advises to rise up to the occasion to clothe the naked (those who shiver in cold), give drink to a stranger who is thirsty. Let us do this with love and not as an obligation. Let mercy build up our community of faith to become Christlike.

Let us break bread together. Let us be hospitable to our friends and families. Let us welcome people for our fellowship, especially those who are new and who are strangers among us. Let strangers become friends through our fellowship and those who are new among us may have the joy of becoming friends with us. May the Divine Mercy of Christ, make us move forward to make a difference in our life for His love, poured out on the cross for our redemption.





Society of St. Vincent de Paul. We do not usually try to locate housing itself for people, but here is a case where we are coming to you, our faithful supporters, to see if you have resources or knowledge to help a refugee family from Turkey. We have been working with the family now for 4 months, and there has been only one place they could have rented for what they can afford. They declined it at the time as it was far from the present school. Since No-

vember, when the pipes in their first house froze and the house flooded, they have been staying in a 1-bedroom motel suite at a price already beyond their means. The adults have work permits and are accepted as refugee claimants. They are not sponsored by any church or civic group, as they entered as asylum seekers. They are in great need of support and St. Vincent de Paul invites you to join us in helping.

They need to have a place where there is a school nearby and that is on a bus route to have access to stores and work. Although they will make a 2-bedroom place work for them, landlords have their pick of tenants, sometimes among dozens of people; because the family is not chosen, they are now critically in need of a place to rent by the end of the month when the motel will cost far too much for them to remain. If you are or if you know any property manager, owner or landlord, please consider making a recommendation to accept this family as tenants. St Vincent de Paul volunteers have spent many hours with the family, arranging and visiting rental homes, calling landlords and seeking other information about skills, experience and interests of the adults and children. In spite of 5 people sharing a motel unit, their place is always tidy and clean; we are offered tea and a snack and treated to beautiful stories of customs and family in their homeland. They are a lovely, lovely family, very desirous of making a good life in Canada, but are now feeling discouraged that Canada does not seem to be able to welcome them, especially because of the children! These are very dear and well-behaved children — a girl who will be in middle school come September and two boys, 9 and 7 years of age. The couple has a dependable, if modest, income afforded to immigrant families in their situation. They live very economically and are skilled at budgeting.


