PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

This week we celebrate the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Nelson Diocese has prepared a special Prayer for Vocations and we are recommended to recite this prayer every Sunday in all our weekend services after the Universal Prayer (Prayer of the faithful) Today we celebrate the 'Good Shepherd Sunday' (John 10:14 "I am the good shepherd; I know my own and my own know me") Jesus was a true shepherd. He was genuine with his sheep. He led them to rich pastures. He cared for them. He loved his sheep, and the sheep followed him.

Pope Francis appealed to the 'true shepherds and apostles of the modern era, to smell the sheep, go to the peripheries'. The Pope is doing a fantastic job of reaching out to those in need and in a timely manner visits with those who need him most. He has become a true shepherd. He is a wonderful role model for the modern-day missionaries. Jesus was trustworthy and the people followed him. Similarly, the Christian faithful are happy to follow the lead of Pope Francis. Jesus became the Shepherd and Guardian of the New & Redeemed Community of Israel. Pope Francis is imitating his master to the fullest extent.

Shepherds risk their life for their sheep. Jesus laid down his life for the sake of humanity (He sacrificed his life on the cross, for the redemption of the world) Jesus was not a hired servant. Jesus was not a hired hand. Hired hands are not dependable (they are not mindful of the sheep because their job is just temporary) So, they work for wages / salary. They do not manifest a real concern for their sheep as they work for monetary benefit only.

True shepherds know their sheep/flock. Jesus is the perfect shepherd because he has true concern for the whole human race. He cares for everyone,

whether they belong to his fold or otherwise. Those who hear his voice respond to this true shepherd and they grow in faith which leads to eternal life. It is Jesus, who creates 'New Communities' in the human world. This initiative is from the Divine. We humans cooperate with God, through our goodwill.

Today, we are reminded of our Christian Leadership. Christian Leadership should lead us to know the sheep (smell the sheep). Knowledge of the local community leads to a selfless service to the people of God. The true shepherd is keen on his flock. He shows them the way. He desires the best for his sheep. He leads them to fresh waters & green pastures. The true shepherd builds up a solid relationship with each and every sheep of his flock. Psalm 23 further explains the salient features of the 'good shepherd'. May God provide his church with dedicated and selfless shepherds to minister to His People!




DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE
