His beautiful hymn of praise calls the Sun and Moon Brother Sun and Sister Moon! The Galaxy of Stars and the Planet Earth and all that is within is honored because they reveal the Holiness of God, attributes St. Francis of Assisi.

These days Climate Activists all over the World conscientize people with their thoughts on 'how we need to care about the planet earth' through their untimely organizational skills to create a sensation around the world. #### **COVID-19 PROTOCOL**




