SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Divine Call" is understood as 'Divine Plan/Divine Initiative' which is the focal point of this week's Scriptures. It is also recognized as a gratuitous gift of the Divine. The Book of Isaiah 5th chapter explains the 'Call of Israel' as a whole nation that was called, (V7 The vineyard of the Lord of hosts is the house of Israel and the people of Judah are his pleasant planting). God also called personalities like Abraham (Father of Faith) Hebrews 11:7 "Abraham obeyed when he was called". Moses the liberator of the Hebrews was called (Ex 3:4 "God called Moses from the Burning bush") God called Elijah the Great Prophet of Israel (1 Kings 19:9,13) "The word of the Lord came to Elijah saying; What are you doing here Elijah?". Apostle Paul was called by the Risen Christ (Acts 9:5, & Chapters19 & 21) "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me? He asked, 'Who are you, Lord?'. 'I am Jesus whom you are persecuting'. All the 12 Apostles were called by the Lord, (Mk 1:17 "Follow me and I will make you fish (fishers) for people". All these personalities were commissioned to be Emissaries and Messengers of the Good News.

God's call is a gift, which creates a 'special bond / relationship' between God and the one who is being called. (Jeremiah 31:31-34) "I will be your god and you will be my people". This relationship requires fidelity and faithfulness. God expects us to be faithful to His Covenant love & reciprocate it by our unconditional trust in His goodness. God calls whoever He wishes to carry out His Plans. All those who are called become His Stewards (1 Cor 4:1) "Christ's Stewards are required to be found Trustworthy" as they are his disciples, servants, coworkers and in a way watchmen of god's treasures of the Good News. Their primary duty is to listen to God very attentively, digest the message in their heart and soul through prayer and reflection to lead their people to execute/carry out God's promptings.

Mother Mary became a great Disciple of God for all time, as she received God's Word & gave expression to it in obedience.

As people of God, we are also called and commissioned by our baptism to become sons and daughters of God and give expression to God's Hopes & Dreams for us and to the World. We are invited to give a receptive ear like Mother Mary with a willing heart and spirit. She encountered God in her ordinary circumstances of life. We are encouraged to be aware of His Divine Presence (Don't you know that you are the temple of the Holy Spirit 1Cor 6:19)

and encounter with our Divine. The first disciples of John (John 1:35-42) had this willing ear and listening heart to encounter the lamb of God (Jesus Christ). They developed the receptivity to respond to Divine promptings and cooperated with their encounters.

Today's Scriptures extend a call to explore the possibilities of our timely encounters with Christ. Pope Francis reminds us to encounter people in the 'beer parlors' especially in the company of friends and acquaintances. Most people encounter wonderful personalities at odd situations in an unexpected way under different circumstances. Such encounters lead to 'lasting memories and exciting moments in our life'. The life of the first disciples of Christ and the life of Paul are great examples of these unexpected encounters. We all could find a 'treasure' (2 Cor 5:7) if we are able to encounter Christ in our life! All the best.

Every year there is a Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. This year it will be January 18 to 25, 2024.




