PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

This week's Scriptures explore the possibility of the 'Spread of the Word of God'. The early Church witnessed a real growth of the Church due to the persecution of the New Christians. The New Christians who experienced the unforetold exiles due to their persecution, went around the neighboring Countries to settle down and to preserve their family. They became God's tool / instrument to Spread His Word. In a way, they were commissioned by the Holy Spirit for the Missionary Activity. Psalm 66 helps us remember the mighty deeds of God in Hebrews' history, (Crossing the Red Sea) God saved our foreparents in faith through the waters of the Red Sea. For ages they continue to remember and acknowledge this saving act of God and praise Him with thanksgiving. This is a wonderful act of gratitude towards the goodness of God.

Apostle Peter in his letter (1 Peter 3:15-18) Encouraged the Christian people to imitate the role model of Christ in our life and follow through with our impeccable conduct and reputation. Christ's death has demolished the walls of hostility between the (Hebrews & Greeks). God and Humans have established Peace by His Blood on the Cross, giving us victory over Sin & Death. Therefore, Christ's vivifying Spirit and its Presence renews, transforms and helps us change our earthly condition to a Heavenly Inheritance. Therefore, we need to seek the Spirit of God / Holy Spirit in our everyday life praying that God the Father may Give us the Paraclete / Holy Spirit. Through the Holy Name of Jesus, we should ask Christ the Lord to send us His Spirit. "Ask and Pray for, Believe that you have it already, and it will be yours". (Mk 11:24)

The Gospel of John 14: 15-21 Encourages the believers to request Christ the Lord through HIS Father and the Spirit. Therefore, the Church teaches that we should always 'request God in Jesus' Name!'. Then the Father will send the Paraclete / The Holy Spirit. (Jn 14:16) Who is the Paraclete? He is the advocate, helper and mediator. Paraclete will be with the Church always. He inaugurated the era of the Church of the Spirit. To the Paraclete, Divine Presence & Sanctification is attributed. The Spirit guides the Church in Truth (Truth is the Characteristic of the Spirit) The World cannot accept the Paraclete because the World looks for 'alternative facts and falsehoods.

The World did not accept the Son of God ("He came to his own, and his own did not receive Him" Jn 1:11) The Eternal Word of God (Logos) took the Human Flesh and we saw His Glory.

The Eternal Word / Son of God (Jesus) is the Revelation of the Father...but the World cannot accept Him. But those who accept Him / recognize Him, are given 'Grace' (Faith) to perceive the Presence of the Spirit. The Holy Spirit indwells both in the Church and in every individual Christian. (1 Cor 6;19 "Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit") The Holy Spirit makes us all 'New Creatures'. "If anyone is in Christ, he is a New Creation" (2 Cor 5:17) We become members of the Church by Baptism and through adoption we share the glory of Christ, becoming 'heirs and co-heirs with Christ' (Rom 8:17)

This shared life of the Trinity is lived out by every Christian in Love & Obedience. If we adhere to the indwelling power of the Trinitarian God... Christ Event/Pascha, the love of Christ for all humans will be great. We share in His suffering, death, and resurrection. We also share and experience the outpouring of the spirit, which helps us to make a huge difference in our lives. May the good Lord bless us to bear a credible witness to Christ in all our life situations.


SANTACRUZAN 2023

The Filipino Community of The Catholic Parishes of Penticton, will be hosting the Flores de Mayo Festival this May 2023. It is a festival to show our devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a month-long festival devoted to the Blessed Mother where we will offer prayers, rosaries and a novena in her honor. Flower offerings will be done before Sunday masses by children during this month. The Santacruzan is the pinnacle of the month-long festival. It can be described as a sort of religious historical beauty pageant. It is held to commemorate the discovery of the Holy Cross, where Jesus was crucified and died, by Saint Helena the mother of Constantine the Great who became the first Christian Roman Emperor. The Santacruzan is a procession of young ladies as queens representing the titles of the Virgin Mary. This year the Santacruzan will be held on Saturday, May 27th, 2023, at 2:30 pm at St. Ann's Parish (1296 Main St., Penticton). A Mass will be held after the procession. The Mass will be presided by Fr. Obi and several priests from the diocese.

A fellowship and gathering with dinner will be held in the Parish Hall after Mass. It will be a time for "fiesta" with food music, and games for the kids and young at heart. Join us as we celebrate the rich Filipino traditions and culture.
