PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Pentecost is 'Outpouring of the Spirit' by Jesus and His Father. (The Risen Christ and God the Father send the SPIRIT (the 3rd person of the Holy Trinity to Lead & Guide the Church on this planet earth) Pentecost Sunday celebrates the "Birthday of the Church". Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after the Easter Celebration, as the Hebrews Celebrated the Feast of the Weeks. (Leviticus 23: 15-22) 'Pentecost is a Theophany' which is the Revelation / Manifestation of God. (The images of 'tongues of fire and mighty wind (Acts 2:4) rested on every one of the believers. (This is the interior Spiritual Experience of the Divine by every believer) Yahweh descended on Mount of Horeb in the form of fire.(Ex 19:18) The Spirit is the indwelling Power of God (1 Cor 6:19) in each believer.

Activities of the Spirit: 1. Early Christians were instructed by the Spirit to develop an 'Openness to Receive His Grace' (Acts 15:9) "God can read everyone's heart" by giving them the Holy Spirit. In fact, 'The Holy Holy Spirit opened the hearts of the Gentiles / Non-Jewish people to respond to God's grace / call and became His People. 2. The Spirit is the driving force in the Proclamation of the Gospel. Jesus gave us the mandate, "Go out to the world and proclaim the Good News and Make Disciples" (Mt 28:20) The Spirit motivated the Apostles and the early Christians to branch out to the entire world to proclaim the Good News. 3. The Spirit is the agent of Conversion, not only in the early church but also now in our present world. 4. The Spirit gives the believers Endurance in their suffering & persecution (2 Cor 4: 7-11)

5. The Spirit guides the Missionary efforts of the Church even today (Several & periodical Apostolic

Pilgrimages of the Popes to the international world to strengthen the faith of the believers). 6.The Spirit helps our Evangelization efforts in the modern world, despite the obstacles that we face & inaugurates the Church of God with the believing communities (China) 7.The Spirit bestows gifts of tongues to the believers (Ecstasy) It also assists people to perform miracles (Padre Pio, St. Antony) wonders and spectacular activities in the Holy Name of Christ. 8.The Spirit helps everyone, either a believer or a non-believer to hear the gospel and helps them to live as a world community of brothers and sister. (Ephesians 4: 1-4)

9. The spirit is the 'Creative Breath of God" (Ps 104) God created everything by His Power (Spirit of God) The wonder of the creative power of God is explained in this Psalm. Genesis 2:7 Explains the Creation of Man and Woman: "God fashioned man of the dust from the soil. He breathed into his nostrils a breath of life. Ps 104: 28-30 "When God breaths we live, when He stops breathing, we die". It's the Spirit of God that makes us' New Creation / Creatures' (2 Cor 5:17) 10. This Spirit is the Source of Christian Love, Hope and Faith (1 Cor 13:13) The Spirit gives us adoptive sonship and we become children of God (Gal 4:6, Rm 8:14) It assists us in our prayers and helps us to know the Father God better.

The Holy Spirit is always present in the Church in a visible way, encouraging, guiding and leading. He stirs us to speak about the Mighty Deeds of God and helps others to hear this message loud and clear. Pope Francis on this day encourages everyone to follow the Synodal Path of Renewal of our Christian Commitment to God and to the Church.
