PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

God is "The Alpha and the Omega, (Rev1:8) He is the Lord, who is, Who was and who is to come, the Almighty. He is the Beginning and the End" (Rev 21:6) According to the Christian thought, God is understood in 'Three Persons, Father, Son and the Spirit'. St. Paul in his writings enlarged this understanding by giving 'Functional Roles to the Three Persons of the Trinity', name Father is the Creator, Provider and Sustainer. (Ps 104) The Son is the Redeemer, who frees the human race from Sin & Death (1Cor 15:55) and gives us Eternal life and Immortality. (Wis 3:5-6) The Spirit is the Sanctifier, who dwells in our hearts (1 Cor 6:19) and who bestows us with graces and gifts to engage in good works (1 Cor 12:7) The Spirit is also understood as the Presence of God in the World, which guides and leads the Church. The concept of the Holy Trinity, One God in Three Persons (Father, Son and the Holy Spirit is a great mystery, awesome and powerful. The Five Pillars of the Jewish thought explained further: 1.Humans are created in the image and likeness of God. (Ge 1: 27) "God created humans in the image of Himself. In the image of Him God created us male and female". (When you give breath, fresh life begins. You keep renewing the world. When you stop their breath, everything dies") Ps 104 :29. 2.Humans have to obey God's laws. (Jer 31: 33-34) "Deep within your hearts I will plant my Law. (Deut 6:7 "You shall teach them to your children". (Rm1:17) "The upright find life through faith". God asks us to follow His Laws (Mt 22:34-38) 3. Humans should work with God and relate to God so that we could become heirs and co-heirs with Christ (Rm 6) 4.The World is good, because it is created by God. Humans need to care for it and honor it and should not distort or deplete its resources.

5. Humans expect the Messiah to Come. (But the Christian Hope & Belief is that Messiah had come and has taught us the Value of Love and Service to build a Human Society based on His Beatitudes. (Mt 5:1-12)

The Hebrews pay enormous attention to 'suffering, calamity, inequality & injustice' as all right-minded humans do. Therefore, their value system is built on Justice, Peace and Love. (Rm 14:17) Hebrew Wisdom honours God's greatness, majesty and strength. (Ps 62 & 18) Humans should wait for the Lord, as the Watchman waits for daybreak. There was a deep feeling of a 'Personal God' called 'Yahweh' in the devout Hebrew Life and every Hebrew begins to get attached to this personal God through the reading and recitation of the Torah. (This clear understanding should motivate our Christian faithful to get attached to the personal God, Jesus, Our Redeemer, by our serious commitment to the reading and reflection of the Scriptures.

Trinity should become the model of every Christian family and community life, explained Pope Benedict XVI. According to him, families are based on Trinitarian love, especially shared love between the Father, Son and the Spirit which is mutual and reciprocal. Therefore, the Pope advised sharing our love with everyone, We should be welcoming and outgoing. Appreciating and accompanying as Jesus did in His life. Share your love in the community of faith to build stronger bonds of goodwill specially to tolerate the differences of people and to experience the Christian Unity in diversity. Connect with all. Recognize the gifts and talents of people and grow in Christian maturity. May Love reign supreme in our hearts and our communities!
