### PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

“Crisis Management” is something very important in everyone's life. Crisis is something disruptive and an unexpected event that threatens to harm people. But a crisis also leads to a turning point in life. Crisis period is a decisive or crucial time that enlightens the individual. Crisis may be Spiritual, Psychological, Physical, Emotional, Moral, Financial and often-times relational too. Individuals should be able to identify such a time and acknowledge them with honesty. It will not be a great idea to deny the crisis or escape it.

Spiritual crises pop up when we face sudden challenges in life. (Examples of sudden death of a loved one, unforeseen health condition due to ailment, loss of employment, life changing accidents, break in marriage/end of a relationship, children running away from home, drug related incidents and so on). When we are burdened with the 'spiritual Crises' we question our faith/our belief/faith in God is questioned by the sufferer. 'God is testing me' is the groaning /complaint of people.

Saint James explained: (Jm 1:13) 'God does not tempt us and God cannot be tempted'. The fact is, 'we are tempted by our own desires / inclinations, and we stumble. When something unexpected happens we question God, 'Why me?'. In these situations, we are confused and get into disorientation, and we begin to question our faith itself. I am so faithful, but why does God allow me to suffer? Most often we think that bad things should only happen to bad people. But it is not true. Bad things also can happen to good people.

Spiritual Crises lead to inner struggle and spark an existential threat & depression. This type of depression leads to clarity of thought and reasoning.

Examples are plenty from Job, who lost everything at the blink of an eye and the modern Church Crisis with the scandals, corruption & mismanagement of public funds has brought down the reputation of the Church very drastically... Having lost everything, Job struggled to regain his strength in the Almighty Power of God. He never gave up. He always pondered, "My Redeemer is Living".

Christ in his crisis prayed, "Father, let this cup pass away, but not my Will, but let thy Will be done". Even though Christ was tormented with inner suffering, he opted to listen to his loving Father. This is what we call inner vision, clarity of thought. This is an authentic way of expressing one's faith in the Almighty Power when we suffer untold misery or turmoil.

The Spiritual and Psychological crises of Prophet Jeremiah explains his mental, physical and spiritual state of life. His observance of the adverse situation around him was referred to as 'terror on every side'. He experienced bullying, intimidation, and mockery. But he did not give up his commitment to Yahweh...'the living God'. He became, 'a just sufferer' for Yaweh. A client of the Almighty. Much the same, the quality of the Apostle / disciple is to be 'Trustworthy' even when one is challenged or troubled... The example of Jeremiah is quite inspiring for servants of God, especially we, the followers of Christ. We are the Just Sufferers. (2 Cor 4:7-11) "In all our difficulties, we carry the mark of Christ in our mortal bodies".

May the good Lord help us!

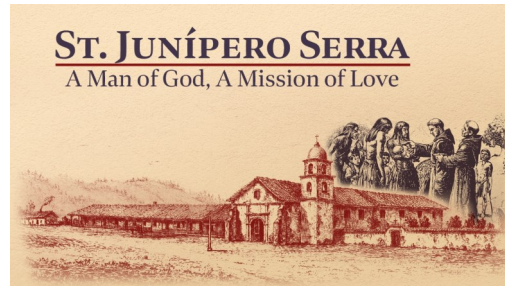

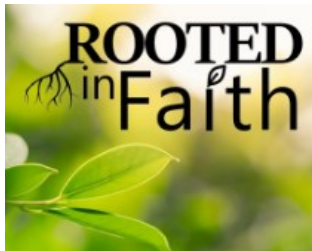

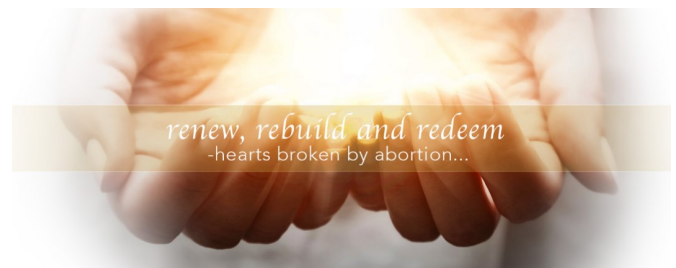

## DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS

The third **World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly** will be celebrated this year on **Sunday, 23 July 2023**. Pope Francis inaugurated this World Day to be celebrated by the universal Church each July, either on or near the liturgical Memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, grandparents of Jesus, to help “treasure the spiritual and human wealth that has been handed down from generation to generation”.

Pope Francis’ chosen theme for this year’s World Day is **“His mercy is from age to age”** (Lk 1:50), raising the relational interconnection between the old and the young. The theme is especially fitting in light of the upcoming World Youth Day (WYD) in Lisbon, which will take place from 1-6 August 2023. To showcase this theme, the **CCCB Standing Committee for Family and Life, in tandem with its Office**, produced a [30 second video](#) which captures a group of high school students visiting the elderly at a retirement home. The heartwarming interaction of old and young wonderfully represents this year’s World Day theme and inspires us to find concrete and creative ways to draw near to the elderly.

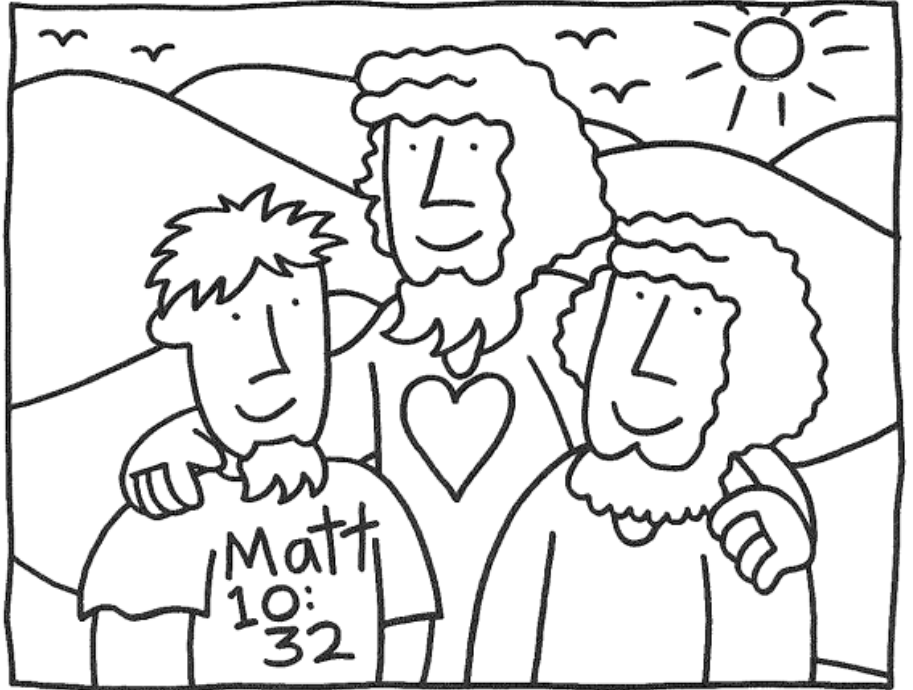
