PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

This week's Scripture from Romans 8:9, 11-13 is quite intriguing because it invites us to have the 'Spirit of Christ'. Christians are to develop a deep 'Spiritual Attachment to Christ'. This is no mere external identification with the cause of Christ, or even a grateful recognition of what He once did for humanity, (the death on the Cross). Rather, the Christians who belongs to Christ is the one, empowered 'to live for God' through the vitalizing influence of His Spirit. Without the Spirit of Christ, the source of Christian vitality / life, is like a corpse because of the influence of sin (Rm 5:12). But in union with Christ the Christian lives, because the Spirit resuscitates the dead human being through the gift of uprightness / the justice of God which is His Mercy.

The Scripture says that if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, 'he / she does not belong to Christ' (Rm 8:9) ... not the true child of God. Therefore, the question is: "What kind of Spirit did Christ have?" To be true followers of Christ, we are invited to live, act and behave like Christ. Some may ask: Christ got angry in his life a few times; in fact, he was very angry at one point. With a whip in one hand, He shouted, you have made my Father's House, a den of thieves. (Mk 11:15-19) He was often short-tempered with the hypocrites especially with the Jewish Rabbis and the leaders of the synagogues. He called them snakes / broods of vipers. But most of the time, Christ was very much outgoing, pleasant, and optimistic. He manifested His kindness and gentleness when He preached and interacted with His people. He was loving, gentle, meek and welcoming. He was forgiving, full of mercy even when He was on the Cross, He was outgoing with mercy & peace.



He was friendly with the outcastes, underprivileged, sick, dying and alienated. He loved them deeply. He made a great impact on their lives. He is sending a message today for all of us ..."Love People", especially the rejected, excluded / pushed aside, left wounded and the lost sheep who were never unsearched for. In the words of Pope Francis, "Go to the Peripheries and seek out the lost & the least". Go out of your way to speak to those you can. What is essential is the spirit of connection and warmth that we manifest and share with others. If we do so, We will love like He loved. He still loves us and comes around telling us that we are His Special People, calling us 'Sons and Daughters'.

The Spirit of Christ is vibrantly expressed in our Love & Service. His best example is stooping down to wash the disciples' feet (Jn 13). He was least bothered about their clothes, the groups they belonged, the guarrels they entertained and the beliefs they nurtured. He saw everyone with that Eye of the Divine. He treated everyone equally with dignity and honour. He cared for them, listened to them and participated in their lives totally. He waited on people with great care and warmth. These and other attitudes and manners of Him impressed them most. Everyone felt touched, cared and loved. Can we also do our best to be closer to Him, seeking to follow and be led by Him. May the Spirit of Christ impel us to recommit ourselves to live this Christian way of life to the fullest extent.




LITTLE FLOWERS OF ST. FRANCIS
