SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

'Discipleship' is the theme of this Sunday. Disciples are companions of Jesus. They are recruited from mixed backgrounds, forming a multicultural group with a variety of professional skills. Some seem to be from the upper class (elite group). Some do not have any social status at all. Yet some others are identified as Ordinary, middle-class people. A few others are from radical backgrounds. The first four disciples of Christ were Peter, Andrew, John & James. Jesus saw them at the shore of Galilee (Fishing folks) and invited them to join Him to fish People ("Come after me and I will make you fishers of people". Mk 1:20) They were fascinated by this penniless vagabond & left their lucrative fishing trade and went after him. These men formed the 'Inner circle of Christ' and the Bible witnesses to their private encounters. (Probably Jesus confided his heart to these men).

Apostle Matthew was from Capernaum, a famous trade centre in the ancient world. He was indeed a very wealthy man. Jesus also called Philip and Bartholomew from Bethsaida, in the territory of Galilee. Both men were very committed to Jesus' teachings. Apostle Thomas was a 'skeptic for excellence' because he always wanted to probe deep into the matter to get the nuance out of it. But he turned out to be a wonderful witness to the Resurrection of Christ with his famous phrase "My Lord & My God" (Jn 20:28) Simon the Zealot was from a 'Radical Group' (Zealots were warriors and so they are unpredictable). James, Son of Alpheus, was a humble man. Thadeus was also a humble person, who was named by the Church as a man of great honor because of his intercessory prayers on behalf of the believers. Finally, we come to know 'Judas Iscariot', the man who played the trump card as per the plan of the Divine.


He was often quoted for the 'love of money' and Apostle Paul was able to comment on this aspect...'love of money is the root cause of all evils'. But all these men were captivated by the personality of Jesus.

Jesus was a 'Charismatic Leader' and his charisma captivated not only these men but also a large contingent of the crowd from the Hebrew world in his time and continues to gather multitudes of people even today in the 21st Century. Jesus had a 'radical love for people' and he made people his priority. His enthusiasm and optimism stirred up the attention of his hearers. So, people always wanted to be around him and wished to experience him deeply and intimately. They were very much committed to hearing and following him. Therefore, we come to understand that discipleship is a calling and Jesus calls us by our Baptism, giving a New Name and a New Office to fulfil. This New office is a Commission to make His Good News available to all people of goodwill. He is inviting us for this Mission today in our locality. We can reach out to our friends and families if we are able to share our time, talents, and resources by becoming Jesus' Companions in the Journey!


Thank you to all who are participating in the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity this week of January 18 to 25, 2024.




