Since its inception in 2008, Ozanam Recovery House has **helped more than 750 men change their lives.**

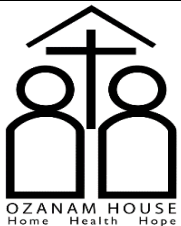
OUR CURRENT NEED
