SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Action is the Test of Obedience!", is the message that we deduce from this week's Scriptures. The scriptures make it clear that believers are not to live in 'self-deception' (Mt 7:21) "NOT EVERYONE WHO CALLS ME, LORD, LORD" will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only those who do the will of my Father in Heaven. Devout invocation of the Name of Jesus and calling him Lord, along with the reception of the gifts of the spirit of the Apostles don't guarantee anyone as a Genuine Disciple of Jesus Christ. Everyone should prove through their faith and to its commitment in action. 'Let our faith work through our Love' (Gal 5:6) advises Paul.

In order to explain this Christian Calling and Commitment Mathew 21: 28-32 Uses the Parable of the Two Sons. a) 'Elder Brother' refers to the Jewish Leaders such as the Pharisees, Sadducees, Scribes, Levites & the Priests. b) 'Younger Brother' refers to the Tax Collectors, Prostitutes and the Vulnerable people of the Jewish community especially the Crowd. The parable contrasts the verbal rebellion and the ultimate obedience of the Younger Son as opposed to the verbal obedience and ultimate disobedience of the Elder Son...and his utter failure to act.


The Younger Brother is identified with the 'Despised Class' that listened to Jesus and transformed their lives. Whereas the Elder Brother is identified with the 'Elite Class' of the Jewish society which opposed the preaching of Jesus and failed to hear or listen. They ultimately refused to be transformed from their critical comments and opinions. The Jewish Law demands 'Faith shown in Action' (Deut 6:4-9) But the Jews expressed their faith in the Law but did not live their Law / Commandment of God. They observed the law out-worldly to fulfill certain 'social customs' in order to appear good before the common crowd.

The Jewish people did not consider (Failed) that their Law had some room for Repentance, even though they were reminded by the Torah about the 'Day of Atonement' (Lev 16) John the Baptist & Jesus decried this moral failure of the Jews and encouraged them to be faithful & obedient to the Law, but the 'hard hearted' Jews failed drastically and did not repent. Whereas the Gentile sinners, who did not know the Law & who lived in Sin, when told of their failures, repented & modified their way of life. They became worthy of the Reign of God.

The Elite Class Challenged Jesus and his authority. They were indeed critical of Jesus and waited for an opportunity to discipline him. The Ruling Class of the of the Jews appeared to listen but conceited. But the Gentiles expressed their Love & Commitment to the teachings of Christ. Therefore, today's scriptures invite us for a soul search...'What about us?'.

If we wish to be the disciples of the Lord, both in our Word and Life, we need to be truthful. In order to lead a humble & honorable life, we need to follow our conscience all through our life and existence. Through 'Repentance' let's have a 'Change of Heart' leading to a changed behavior / pattern to living. Let's humbly pray; 'Create a clean heart, O God. Take away the heart of stone and give me a heart of Flesh & Blood" (Eze 36:26)








The Society of St Vincent de Paul at this parish is searching for volunteers to help us serve our neighbours in need as auxiliary members.
