SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"We are planted & rooted in Christ (Col 2:7) Continue to live your lives' in Him". "You will be my people and I will be your God"(Jer 31:33-34) "I shall give you a New heart and put a New Spirit in you" (Eze 36:26-29), seems to be the message that we get from the Scriptures of this weekend liturgy. Isaiah, the great Prophet of Israel revealed the hard truth about the people of Israel (Is 5:1-5) that they were gathered from everywhere and were organized as a Nation. God gave them good leaders to guide, protect and care for, but the Israelites engaged in war and bloodshed. God expected them to bear good fruits (live a worthy & honorable life engaging in good works), instead they failed God by engaging in violence.

We are God's plants & God has a purpose in our lives. But as humans, we go against God's intent and deviate from our 'right living' by committing evils & errors. Naturally, God is displeased & disappointed with the humans because of our poor 'reception of (grace) what was / is planted in our hearts. The People of Israel did not follow God's ideals and values (living in the presence of God, knowing what's right & wrong, engaging in diligent work and honoring the vulnerable especially the orphans, destitute & widows), rather they engaged in cheating, violence, immorality and failed to treat the vulnerable. They even worshipped other Gods. In fact, they went away from the True God following other forms of cults.


Despite their stiff-necked behaviour and hardheartedness, God had Mercy on them. God's call and action transformed them as a New Creation (2 Cor 5:17) God had mercy on them because the Justice of God is the Mercy of God. (Lk 6:36) Similarly, our justification by Christ on the Cross is the utter gratuitous gift of God (Rm 3:26) and it comes from God himself.


As humans we too have sinned and have fallen short of the grace of God. But God, out of His benevolent mercy has brought redemption through Christ and has given us a chance to modify our behaviour.

The Old Testament frequently compared the 'Chosen People' (Israelites) to the vineyard that God planted, which was tented by the Prophets (who were also called 'Slaves / Leaders') But the Israelites killed them. Finally, God sent His Own Son, whom the Israelites expelled him out of the vineyard and killed him. Judaism rejected the Messiah, but the Messiah became the 'Keystone / Cornerstone of the New People of God (The church) and we are to be like the Vine and the Branches. Christ is the Vine, and we are the Branches. This explains our abiding relationship with Christ the Lord and His Companions in the journey (Pilgrim church). Therefore, Christian life is modelled on the analogy of the Vine & Branches.

Our Christian Community life is a call to 'share and care' as the vine and the branches. Christ's life impacts us as a source to do good works. Our union with Christ is essential to bear fruit and it is expected from every believing member. John 15:14 Gently reminds: "No one has greater love than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends". Christian life has its model from Christ himself. May the love of Christ give us this ability to live our calling fully by being planted and rooted in Him.



When we feel that God is calling us to intervene with others in these social dynamics, we should realize that this too is part of our spirituality, which is an exercise of charity and, as such, matures and sanctifies us."




