SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

Christianity is a living experience of 'Christ's Life' seems to be the message that we get from today's Scriptures. Jesus taught us (Mt 22:34-40) the Two Great Commandments: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind and You shall love your neighbour as yourself". Therefore, love of God and neighbour was / is the principal teaching of Christ. This week's liturgy is an invitation to live out these Two Commandments effectively in our lives because on these Two Commandments hang the whole law and the prophets.

According to the Bible, 'the love of God' comes from the Book of the Torah (Deuteronomy 6:4-6) "God is One. Love Him with all your Heart, Soul, Will & Strength". 'The love of neighbour comes from the Book of Leviticus 19:18. "You must love your neighbour as yourself". Christ was a practical man and he taught people with clarity of thought & mind. Moses the Visionary received the 10 Commandments from God at Mt. Zion and taught the Hebrews to adhere & follow them sincerely for the honor of the deity and their own sanctification, because He delivered them from the hands of the Egyptians by opening up the Red Sea providing a release from their bondage. He also blessed them with manna & quail in the Wilderness.

The Rabbis (Teachers of the Law) who came after Moses fabricated the 10 Commandments into 613 commandments. Out of which 365 are negatives (Don'ts) and 248 are positives (Do's). The ordinary Hebrews could not follow all these commandments and Jesus called them 'Yoke/Burden' laid on the shoulders of people (Mt 11:28-30) Therefore when he was questioned about it, he gave the thoughtful answer: "Love your God & Neighbour".


We would be wondering 'who are our neighbors?' The scriptures explained that 'all people created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:27) are our neighbours. We are the Children of God, and all are created in His image and likeness. Therefore, we have no reason to discard anyone on the basis of our likes and dislikes.

If we are sincere, we should rise up above our pettiness of discrimination based on someone's colour, language, origin, language, culture or tradition and lifestyle. Christ today sends a powerful message to us to treat everyone with dignity and honor. (Ill Treatment is a violation) Let's be inclusive and not exclusive. Let's try to become channels of God's love for everyone. It's not enough that we love others, but our love should be proved by our actions. 'Let our actions speak louder than words'.

Jesus had unconditional love for everyone, and he went out of himself to connect with those the society excluded (the tax collectors, the vulnerable like the lepers & disadvantaged people) Today Jesus is extending a call for us to treat everyone with His Mindset. Archbishop Oscar Romero of El Salvador gave an eloquent witness in his life for this commandment of Christ. Mother Teresa lived out this Command of love despite the many challenges she endured. Maximilian Kolbe had the courage to die for it. Jesus is asking us not to offer our lives for this great ideal, but he is inviting us to be respectful of others and not alienate anyone from our friendship.

May the good Lord motivate us to live this Commandment of Love!
