SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

This Week's Scriptures call us for a 'Self-examination of Conscience'. The Prophet Malachi (Known as the Messenger of Yaweh) analyses our 'life & ritual'. God created humans in His image and likeness. God also blessed them to live together and populate the earth. The creation of man and woman and the establishment of marriage strongly emphasize the complementary nature of man and woman. Genesis 1:25 Explained the wonder of the man when he saw the woman..."Bone of my bone, flesh of my flesh". Malachai was of the opinion that marriage has its unique wonder, and this wonder has to be kept up and not torn down at any time. As one does not profane the Temple of God, one should not profane the married state at any time, advised Malachai.

The prophet Malachai also was of the opinion, 'One's Life & Faith' should corroborate. Liturgical life should be like a mirror reflecting one's honesty & character in one's daily activity. God is One, Spirit & Life. So, man and wife are to be united in One Spirit & One Flesh. Just as God cannot be divided, neither should man and wife be separated. Since we all belong to the 'Divine Family' we should not desecrate this temple of God. People of God are loved, chosen, and called by God (Rm 8:28-30) Our faith in God should be expressed in our 'Life & Ritual'.

Superficial Faith has no depth. Faith is the Conviction, Hope, that what we hope / expect / envision is achievable. Socrates, the Father of Greek Philosophy taught, 'Humans, know yourself". Self-introspection is the key to an honourable and dignified life. If we wish to live a meaningful life, then better that we know ourselves well, especially our strengths & weaknesses, merits, and limitations. Pharisaic attitude might spring from 'saying something and doing entirely another thing'.

Whenever our Words & actions do not corroborate, and when there's no coherence between our thought and action, we are probably with the Pharisaic mind-set.

Looking good before others or appearing good before others, but inwardly boiling or simmering with hatred or anger, or concealing one's faults and pointing one's fingers at others (skillful ways of finding faults), reveal that we are cheats, hypocrites, blind guides, fools, snakes, or vipers. We pretend & have a mask over our face. We are called 'showoffs' who trumpet our glory or worth before others. Christian life is not and should not be Pharisaic. It should be a life of God's love and concern for everyone. Our faith should be manifested in our service and dealings.

Jesus today unmasks this Pharisaic attitude in our gathering. We need to have a soul search / selfintrospection... if we wish to have a meaningful life. Let's not develop judgmental thoughts. None of us is superior to someone in our environment or in our gathering. We are all equals invested with God's love and blessings. Let's embrace everyone gently and kindly. Let's not consider ourselves as special, important, or influential before others. We all are special to our God and in His sight, we are honored. Abraham Lincoln is a great role model. He searched for his soul to treat everyone equally. He was able to advocate equal dignity and honor for all God's Children but paid the ultimate price to achieve his goal in life. Are we willing to be authentic? Pope Francis reminds us: "Who are we to judge?". May the good Lord bless us with this timely introspection today!




NEW RELIGIOUS EDUCATION COORDINATOR

Pope Francis has written a new, shorter document, following up but not repeating his original apostolic letter Laudato Si' from 2015. 
