SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Are you the King of the Jews?" (Jn 18:33 & Mk 15:2) Christ became King on the Cross. He was born in utter poverty, died on the Cross like a criminal with overwhelming misery, mockery, unimaginable and excruciating suffering. But God Raised Him from death and made Him King of the universe. Apostle Paul wrote in Philippians 2:9-11 " God Exalted Him and Gave Him a new Name, that is above every name. So that at the Name of Jesus every knee should bend in Heaven and Earth, and every Tongue should Confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the Glory of God the Father!". Jesus is a strange King & a Servant Leader who stooped down to wash the feet of His disciples (Jn 13:4-13) He loved serving people with compassion. Finally, he died on the Cross to express His Unconditional love & care.

Jesus was a radical King. Through his radical suffering, he inspired thousands, and millions over the Centuries to Proclaim Him "King of the Jews". The Magi from the East who came to Jerusalem asked King Herod (Mt 2:1-2) "Where is the Child who has been born King of the Jews?". Pilot wanted to ridicule & malign Jesus with the title 'King of the Jews', so that he could charge Jesus with treason. But the title, 'Jesus King of the Jews' has become a code language for the past 2000 years and will continue until the end of time.

Jesus expects us to serve him, and his people just like Him. By our compassionate and merciful love, he is inviting us to Spread His Kingdom. His kingdom is not of the world. But according to St. Paul, 'It is Justice, Peace & Love'. (Rm 14:17) Jesus lived and died for this great ideal (Ephe 2:14) "He is our Peace". In His body He made Jews and Greeks into One and has broken down the dividing wall, that is hostility between us.

Today, it is our turn to establish His Kingdom based on His Principles of Love & Service and the Value system of the Beatitudes (Mt 5:1-12) He is inviting us to be partners with him in this mission.

Pope Pius XI in 1925 instituted this feast to give the Universal World, a role model for governing the citizens based on the ideals of Justice, Peace, and Love (Equity). World (Royals) Kings and Queens of the past had done their best. Though some of them were tyrannical & hateful, others treated people with kindness and worked for people's progress, like Louis IV of France, Queen Elizabeth of Hungary & Queen Elizabeth of England. We read about their lives in our faith formation lessons.

At this great feast, we are reminded by the church that at the end of our Pilgrimage of Faith, all of us will be judged according to our relationship with our sisters and brothers. Today's scripture reiterates that we will all be judged according to the principle of 'love & empathy'. Service to our fellow humans is a service rendered to our God. If we have treated others with Love & Empathy, we will be blessed otherwise we will be considered wicked. God will separate the good and the bad, the righteous and the wicked. The righteous will be justified to reign with God and the wicked will be punished. May we celebrate the feast of Christ the king with jubilation and adore Him as Our Lord & King! All the best.






