SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

'Humans are a work of Art' (Ge 2:7) "The Lord God formed humans from the dust of the ground, and breathed into their nostrils the breath of life, and they became a living being". Prophet Jeremiah wrote, "We are like clay in God's hands" (Jer 18:7) God the artist designs us according to His plan & creates us through our lives, shaping and reshaping us each day through our activities. The English Poet John Keats in 1818 wrote, "A thing of beauty is a joy forever". Michealangelo's work of art, 'God touching the human hand' at the Sistine Chapel in the Vatican, is said to be the best art in the world. Beautiful things leave an indelible mark in our minds and enhance our eternal admiration by boosting our joy & happiness. John Milton's "Paradise Lost & Paradise Regained", was considered to be a masterpiece of art in English literature. In 2013 Alice Munro, an 83year-old Canadian Writer, won the Nobel Prize for literature by presenting simple life stories of the people of this land in an artistic way & impacted greatly the readers & influenced their culture.

Today's Scriptures explain this Concept of God working in our lives with this thought provoking metaphor/simile of 'a potter working on the potter's wheel'. The Great Prophet Isaiah told us in Chapters 63 & 64 'We are a lump of clay, in the Hands of God', like the ancient Israelites, because Israel means to be 'Governed by God'... who shapes, reshapes, transforms, renews & modifies/alters our destinies. As the lump of clay allows itself to be shaped and reshaped by the potter, we humans are invited during this time of Advent, which is a grace filled time to allow ourselves to be formed by God. Jeremiah 29:11 reminds all God's children, "I know the plans I have in mind for you, says the Lord. From page 1...

Plans for Peace, not disaster, reserving a future full of Hope for you". If we allow ourselves to accept God's Plan & Design, he will be able to shape us 'beautiful persons' as a potter makes artistic vessels out of a lump of clay.

Apostle James suggests a few steps (1:18-19) for our consideration during this period.

1) Be quick to listen to the Word of God. God's word has the power to shape us. The Book of Hebrews 4:12 reads, 'The Word of God is a double-edged sword'. Let the Word of God become our guiding principle. Let's be eager to listen to God's Word. 2) Be active to live the Word of God. Create a space for that Word. The best example to consider at this time is the 'Young Virgin Mary', said Pope Benedict XVI. Luke 1:30- 32 "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will Name Him Jesus". Evangelist John Wrote: (Jn 1:14) "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us". Let us allow Christ to pitch His tent in our hearts and minds so that He can mold us into His likeness. Therefore, be optimistic to practice the Word. "Let the Eyes of our Mind be Opened" (Eph 1:17) so that we can become the doers of the Word, not mere hearers only. May the good Lord Jesus help us in this journey!






Bake Sale Nov 18 & 19, 2023
