SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Prepare the Way of the Lord!" (Is 40:3) 'The way' is a manner of life and John the Baptist broke open the concept of 'right living' according to the Principles of, The Torah, which Moses was able to help the Hebrews/Israelites follow. Today we understand 'Christianity is the Way' because Jesus said, (John 14:6) "I am the Way, The Truth & The Life". The Prophet Micah 6:8 asks the beautiful question: "What does the Lord require of you?" 1. To Love Kindness 2. To Execute Justice & 3. To Walk Humbly with the Lord. St. Paul, in Romans (14:17), explained the same concept in the following verse: "For the Kingdom of God is not food and drink, but Love, Peace and Justice". Christ very clearly explained in Mt 22:37-39 "You shall Love the Lord your God with all your Heart, Soul, Mind & You shall Love your neighbours as yourself". Pope Francis in a very gentle way reminds us, "Be merciful just as your Heavenly Father is merciful".

The Evangelist Mark extends an invitation to all God's Children announcing the "Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God". For Evangelist Mark, 'the gospel is the way' which leads to God. The Gospel is the 'good news' which guides us to our 'salvation in Christ'. This good news is Jesus Himself. The Gospel is an invitation to our 'Witnessing Life' through our discipleship. John the Baptist inaugurated this 'ministry of witnessing' in the wilderness when he called people for repentance (transformation from the old way / style of life to a New Reformed Encounter with the person of Jesus) for a righteous living. His main goal was to establish a friendship with God and to be proactive to do good for others. (Creating New Heaven & Earth. Rev 21:1) God will purify with His Truth all the evil deeds of people and will Refine them for himself by cleansing our wickedness like the waters of purification.

Advent is a journey through the 'desert of our lives'. When we walk this journey we will experience the 'Tenderness of God' explained Pope Benedict XVI, because God will Give us Hope by speaking to us softly to motivate us for a renewal experience. Therefore, we are reminded by the Church that our desert experience should be 'Internal & External' referring to our 'Conscience' in the first place to explore the possibilities of our weaknesses & failures this allows ourselves to be healed & restored, to blossom once again with peace & prosperity.

Secondly, we need to get away from our 'distractions' so that we may begin to have a deeper intimacy with the Divine. Perhaps this is how the Israelites were guided in the Wilderness. God visited with them and met their needs, strengthening them through His Presence. Desert journey takes us away from our normal life and prepares us for a deeper vision of our existence. According to G.K Chesterton, "Desert is a land under God's Care'. T.S Eliot is of the opinion that 'desert is a wasteland, unfruitful & unproductive". May God help us explore our 'Spiritual wilderness', the feeling of absence of God in our lives especially 'dryness in our prayer life'. May God help us to Bloom & Blossom in His presence through our continued introspection of our lives!




