### **SCRIPTURE MESSAGE**

This Sunday is known as Gaudate Sunday/Rejoicing Sunday. We Rejoice with the young virgin Mary who had been miraculously blessed to conceive 'Jesus Christ'/ The Messiah / The Son of God, the Second person of the Holy Trinity. We echo her song of 'Thanksgiving', "My soul exults in my God, for He has done mighty things for me" (Lk 1) JOY is more than Happiness. Joy means Gladness, Cheerfulness & Calm Delight. Happiness is an emotion which is born of the mind, especially like a timely kiss or exchanging of pleasantries like the Christmas Wish or Congratulating the Newly wedded / graduates. Joy is born of the 'heart' is based on deeper relationships such as a Golden wedding Anniversary. Joy is the gift of the Holy Spirit (Gal 5:22) Joy makes our life meaningful and beautiful. Joy helps us get through our untimely challenges and fills our hearts with gladness. Apostle Paul in 1 Thes 5:16-24 discussed this as the 'Christian Spirit', which is oriented towards God, when we engage in Prayer & Thanksgiving out of Gratitude.

How can we develop this 'Christian Spirit?' The Scriptures help us to nurture, develop and realize this ideal in the following ways. (A) 1. Making Pilgrimage to the Holy Places to Behold the face of God...like the Israelite people. (Ps 122: 2 & 7) "My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth. The Lord will keep you from all evil, He will keep your life from this time on and for evermore". 2. Celebrating our Family Connections especially with our timely visits with all our loved ones especially friends and families. 3. Helping and Supporting the exiled people to resettle comfortably like our ancestors in faith (The Israelites) by giving them hope & encouragement to begin a new life. 4. Restoring people's dignity and honor especially those trafficked and those who have lost their innocence/ identity.

- 5. Like our Blessed Mother reaching out to those with love & kindness, who need our timely care and attention, especially the homebound, elderly and our own parents.
- (B) Prayer. Prayer is the fundamental expression of our Religious Sentiments, esp., looking up to God in our heart & mind, by establishing a personal contact leading to a lasting relationship with the deity. Our daily sacrifice/suffering is Prayer in action. The Book of Deuteronomy 26:1-10 Explains the 'offering of first fruits, festival of weeks and the harvest festivals'. In prayer we Sing, Dance. Beat/Play Musical Instruments and Read the Scriptures & reflect on them. People in the Old Testament stood to pray. Today, we either sit, kneel or stand to pray. Some prostrate completely to show their reverence. Our external posture helps to express our intention & disposition before the deity. Psalm 95:6 "Come, let us kneel down before the Lord. Let's bow down before His Holy Temple". The Catechism of the Church #11 tells us that 'Eucharistic Liturgy is the Summit and Source of all Prayers". We remember what Jesus has done for us for ever and ever in this Liturgical Prayer.
- (C) Thanksgiving: Psalm 116 Explains this concept of 'thanksgiving' as 'fulfilling our vows/promises to God'. God has blessed us with several blessings that we sought for and obtained from His loving hands. (Health from sickness, Peace of mind & heart from a Challenging situation, unforeseen turbulences in our personal & public life & so on). Our God is always on our side, and we rely on His timely help. When our request is realized, we, out of gratitude for the blessings and favours received, 'raise the cup of salvation' (Ps 116:13) This Cup of salvation is a blessing, whereas 'the cup of wrath' (Is 51:17) is the 'suffering cup' which God gives to us when we go away from His loving presence. We offer the Holy Mass everyday out of gratitude for the Lord's closeness and nearness to us both in times of Joy & Suffering. But today, we, with great gratitude, offer this Holy Sacrifice for Sending His Son, Jesus, into the world as our Redeemer/Saviour through Mother Mary! With her we Rejoice to Celebrate this Holy occasion.




