PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

Bulletin Message for o4th Sunday in Ordinary Time,

This week's Scriptures break open the 'Reign of God

or the Good News of the Reign' (Mt 5:1-12) Moses

29th January 2023, Weekend

had his revelation at Mt. Zion, the mountain of the Lord! Jesus is the New Moses and he is giving his people the New Revelation of God on the mountain. (I stood at the Sermon on the Mountain spot in Galilee to offer my first Mass when I went to Jerusalem. It gave me an intense feeling of warmth to experience the mountain top ecstasy of his disciples) The Sermon on the Mount is understood to be the 'Magna Carta / Supreme Manifesto' of Jesus. By these thought-provoking sayings, Jesus replaced the strict observance of the Jewish Law (which had 613 Human Regulations (of which, 365 are negatives and 248 are positives). With His Gentle expression of Love. Mother Theresa of Calcutta added that 'we need to put extra love' to activate them in our life. Beatitudes are considered to be a 'Rich Treasure of God's Revelation', inviting His sons and daughters for a credible and life changing experience, which we call Transformation. This change /transformation is not only physical/ external but also spiritual / interior to oneself. Both enhance the Holiness of life, which is known as 'to be found worthy of God's Presence'. This is seeing the face of the Almighty and leading a righteous life/right living (maintaining a balanced relationship in our dealings with our friends, families & neighbours). Ultimately beatitudes call us to put our love for God into action. Rather than 'lording our people & dominating with power & aggression', we are reminded by the beatitudes to show deference in all matters.

Jesus gives us the Role Model of Love, "Walking Extra Miles", every day in all instances. This love is expressed in total relationship with God, and it should not have any hidden agendas. It's not for a punitive gain, because it is expressed solely in the name of the Almighty, who observes every action of ours in secret and rewards.

The Jews followed the 'Torah' (5 Books of Moses) meticulously and some for the appreciation of the onlookers. These appreciations are temporary and often understood as 'lip service' to satisfy those who were/ are in power, authority & influence. But Jesus teaches 'Genuine Love ...Love of God & Neighbour!'. When things are challenging /overwhelming and very much difficult, Mother Theresa of Calcutta, recommended, to put extra love' in order to merit God's blessings! Like St. Monica, the mother of St. Augustine or like all our earthly parents who love and care for our welfare every day, despite the hurts that we give and the challenges we throw at them.

The beatitudes invite us to have a childlike simplicity to adhere to God's principles and consider all our blessings as the favor of God. We are advised to share that favor with others generously and not to hoard them. Jesus advises us to have 'fraternal charity' in all matters, to enjoy God's Presence & Paradise. We are, time and again reminded of the phrase 'option for the poor' and most of our Saints had given expression to this Christian ideal through their life and commitments. Today, the Church invites us to consider whether we could give a credible Christian witness to this most important teaching of Christ. It's always a wholesome thought to remember that on our final days, God will be eagerly looking for our special actions & connections (walking extra miles) in order to grant us Immortality and Eternal Life in His Paradise! (Mt 25:31-46)




CARE OF CREATION


