## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"You are the Salt of the Earth & Light of the World" (Mt 5:13-14) Disciples of Christ are encouraged to become 'salt & light' to the World. 'Salt' seasons our food. It preserves our food. People love / like salty potato chips. Salt adds taste to our food. 'Light' gives vision to our path / way. 'The light of Christ / the teachings of Christ is salt and light to our faith life because it explains God's principles of 'spirituality & morality adding meaning to our life.

In the ancient world, 'Salt' was a valuable commodity and had been used as currency for trading. The Current English word, 'Salary' comes from the Word, 'Salt'. Modern chemical industries use salt for tanning, dying & bleaching. It's also understood to be an essential commodity for pottery, soap and chlorine.

Sodium, scientifically known as 'Sodium Chloride, is a mineral which is essential for life', says the National Health Institute. Sodium controls human body fluids. It also controls the nerve & muscle function of the human body. It's essential for human health, but too much or too little leads to health complications. Excess sodium leads to blood pressure & stroke. Therefore, we are recommended to reduce salt intake in our life.

Light is good. Without light, we would be in darkness. But Ultraviolet Sunlight is harmful on the human skin. Ultraviolet light is 'Electromagnetic Radiation' and we can't pick it up with our human eye because light has energy. Sun gives vitamin 'D' to strengthen our bones, muscles and body immunesystem. It also helps to maintain our moods, skin conditions and the animal vision. Excess Sun causes 'Skin Cancer damaging the immune system & our eyes'.

#### Hi Families!

It's time to get excited! This February, we're super happy to announce a retreat experience especially for our youth!

On the weekend of February 17th – 20th, The Catholic Parishes of Penticton will be welcoming a travelling retreat team from NET Canada (National Evangelization Teams). NET is a reputable company with teams in many countries, who specialize in connecting with youth and bringing them a meaningful, Christ-centered experience. Whether your child is a practicing Catholic/Christian who is looking to take the next step in their faith, or one who doesn't know Jesus, but is looking to better understand their identity and purpose in life, this retreat will be impactful! As a youth coordinator who has been getting to know this role, this team is on a whole different level! I highly recommend signing up if you can.

This weekend will be broken into two different retreats: One for our junior youth (grades 6-9) and one for our senior youth (grades 9-12). Notice that grade 9 is in both categories. So, there is no cost for your child to attend! There will be plenty of fun, plenty of growth, plenty of meaning... there's no down side. And if they really can't come for both days, please at least come for one.






