PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Sin is an offense against God, a rupture of communion with Him. It damages our communion with the Church. It's a moral transgression against God's Law / Divine Law. It's a rebellion against God & neighbor. (When we fail to love God and esteem people) Sin is therefore a distorted condition or twisted behaviour. It is often called 'guilt'. When someone violates the rights of others, that person commits sin. When people of faith violate the obligations of their life which they have undertaken by their Freewill, they commit sin. (They have abandoned the truth)

What Causes Sin? Evil inclination / desire causes or leads us to sin. Heart is the place which stores evil thoughts and feelings (Jer 16:12) Human heart is treacherous & sinful. Sin damages our life, personality and peace of mind. Sin corrupts our mind (Self Deception & Rationalization) It becomes an incurable wound /disease causing recurring infection in our life, like a rust corroding a vessel. It ruptures the friendship of people and the intimacy/relationship of our Loving God.

A few examples of Human's Sinfulness: Pride, Anger, Adultery, Disobedience, Ingratitude and so on. But God is not responsible for our sinfulness and God hates sins and detest them. Therefore, sin is part and parcel of the individual. Human Free will contributes to sin. Human evil tendency leads to sin. Sins go against God and God's love.

What are the Seven Deadly Sins? 1) Pride: Pride is an excessive belief in one's abilities / self-importance. 2) Envy: Envy is wanting what others have, be it status, ability or possession.

3) Gluttony: Gluttony is a desire to eat or consume more than what we require.

4) Lust: Lust is a strong desire or powerful craving for power, money and sexual gratification. 5) Anger: Anger is the loss of rational self, control and the desire to harm others. 6) Greed: Greed is the desire for material wealth and its gain. 7) Sloth: Sloth is laziness and avoidance of work. One of the modern-day failures of humans is "Apathy & indifference".

Proverbs 6:16-19 cautions: "There are SIX things the Lord hates. Seven are Detestable to Him. 1. Haughty eyes 2. Lying lips 3. Hands that shed innocent blood 4. A heart that desires wicked schemes 5. The feet that are quick to rush into evil 6. False witness and pouring out lies and 7) Anyone who stirs up a conflict in the family or community. The Prophet Ezekiel 28:17 tells us: "Let not your heart become proud because of your beauty.

James 3:5-6 "The tongue is a small organ, but it can cause great damage, if it is not properly protected. (The tongue is like a Fire, which can destroy a real forest like the Amazon)

Humans are bound to fail, but God's grace is poured into our hearts to correct our failures. It requires constant vigilance and perseverance to correct our faults. We need to be truthful to change & correct our old ways of life. We need to develop an interior disposition to follow the commandments of the Lord. It's not just /merely following them externally alone, but with our heart, soul, mind, strength and will we should strive to follow them daily.

Today's Gospel extends a call for "Forgiveness". Jesus himself prayed (Lk 23:34) "Father forgive them for they know not what they are doing" God is generous in forgiving and accepting even the worst offenders in life. Therefore, we should fall on our knees and beg the Lord's mercy and forgiveness for our failures to love Him and our people.

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

31st World Day of the Sick will be Celebrated all over the World on the 11th and 12th of February 2023. Pope Francis invites all Christian faithful to reflect on the fact that "it is especially through the experience of Vulnerability and Illness that we can learn to walk together according to the style of God, which is Closeness, Compassion and Tenderness".

"Experiences of bewilderment, sickness, and weakness are part of the human journey. Far from excluding us from God's people, they bring us to the center of the Lord's attention, for He is our Father and does not want to lose even one of his children along the way", Wrote the Pope.

The Samaritan (Lk 10:37), who was called good, made a difference by helping a stranger who was in need. "He was moved with compassion & made the world more fraternal". The Church is therefore called to measure herself against the Gospel example of the Good Samaritan, in order that she may become a true field hospital, for her mission in acts of care. The plight of the sick is a call that cuts through indifference and slows the pace of those who go on their way as if they had no sisters and brothers.

"The Samaritan called the innkeeper to 'take care of him' (Lk 10:35) Jesus extends the same call to each and every one of us exhorting, to go and do likewise" (Lk 10:37) The parable shows us how a community can be rebuilt by men and women who identify with the vulnerability of others and come forward to lift them up and rebuild their lives for the sake of common good. - Excerpts from the letter of Pope Francis. -
