#### PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" (Mt 5:44-45) is the central message that Jesus wishes to share with us today. In fact, Jesus challenges our behaviors & attitudes. He invites us to show more empathy & compassion when we are faced with enmity, hatred & vengeance. Expressions like 'I hate you, I am outraged by your conduct or action, I want to kill you, I am mad at you, and I am humiliated', etc., send a strong message to the hearer. These are strong 'negative reactions' that we all have in our life.

Jesus gently appeals to our behaviors reminding us (Mt 5:44-45) 'to love our enemies'. As ordinary people, our emotions are hurt or stirred when someone over bounds our boundaries. and at the spur of the moment, we find it very troubling or challenging. So, we use derogatory words to counter that offense. Jesus is teaching us to control our emotions and take control of the challenging / troubling / hurtful situation by our empathy.

The Book of Leviticus deals with the Laws of Worship, Justice, Charity, Personal Holiness regarding Worship and Social Life. Preserving others' personal liberty is very much advised by the author of this book. He advises that we should not take advantage of the weak by stealing or cheating, especially withholding their wages. We should not curse the deaf and a stumbling block for the blind at any time. Rather we should treat the vulnerable with dignity.

Reverence to one's parents and Honor to Our God are priorities of life. Self-love should be the measure of Charity toward our fellow humans. "Love your God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength. You should love your neighbor as yourself". (Deut 6:4 ff)

If we do not practice these principles, we commit sins against charity, which is an offense against God and failure of our responsibility. Therefore, it admonishes us to correct our behaviors.

Retaliation should be avoided. 'No eye for an eye or a tooth for a tooth', but love should reign supreme. Forgiveness and empathy must prevail in our Christian dealings. Pope Francis teaches instead of hating someone, let us try to tolerate their offense or hurt. God sends Sun-Shine and Rain to everyone irrespective of their love or affiliation. We should also show the same kindness to everyone as God does to us. Our Christian morality should distinguish us from the rest. "Christian Community is the Temple of the Living God". (1 Cor 3:16-23) The Indwelling Spirit of God should help us realize this wonderful spirituality of our life. Let us not forget that God gives all things / blessings, for the good of those who love Him.
