Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ!

Palm Sunday explains the extreme struggle of an 'innocent person' in a nutshell. Even though people had brought false charges against Jesus, Pilate three times indicated that he had found Jesus to be innocent. In addition, the 'good' thief asserts, "This man has done nothing wrong", and the Roman Centurion exclaims: "This man was innocent beyond doubt".

Jesus was a faithful servant of God, proclaiming the good news for the poor, healing the sick, liberating those held captive, feeding the hungry, and gathering those who have been rejected and marginalized, He is innocent of any wrong doing, but He aroused the anger and hatred of those who seek to keep the 'status quo' to the point where they want to kill him. In the midst of this hostility, Jesus bears His suffering with Trust in God: "Father, into your hands I commend my Spirit". (Lk 23:46)

Jesus' obedience to his father was heroic. By committing his life for that excruciating suffering and death, he had given a visible expression to his obedience to live out his father's command. The Cry of Christ from the Cross, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Ps 22:1) appears to be very pathetic, as if God has abandoned Christ. In fact, God did not abandon him when he called in his unbearable pain. This was the lament of Christ calling God for help.

Lament is a prayer for help coming out of those, whose pains are unbearable or incurable. When we pass through such intense suffering, we cry, we call out to God . . . and this is how we seek God's help. We do not cry in despair. (In despair, people give up on God) Then begin to feel the absence of God, their

family and friends in their painful situation, even though everyone is near to them physically and spiritually. We feel as if they are far off.

When we suffer, the whole-body aches, even our bones, tongues, jaws, heart and feet. Therefore, suffering is both physical & spiritual. It's also psychological and emotional. Let us not forget in our suffering God, suffers with us and cares for us. He has not abandoned us or left us alone to suffer.

Passion Sunday invites us to be ready and willing to call on the name of God, whenever we are faced with challenges or difficulties in life. Be sure that God is there to help and assist with our situation through His Providential care. Let us not panic, but let us develop courage and fortitude to call on Him all the more.



INDIGENOUS CONNECTIONS

On April 1, 2022 **Pope Francis** addressed the **Indigenous delegation of First Nations, Metis and Inuit** who had met with him at the Vatican to express their experiences and views regarding history of colonization and residential schools in Canada (Turtle Island). The full translated text of his comments and apology can be viewed here: https://www.ctvnews.ca.

Below are a few highlights.

"All this has made me feel two things very strongly: indignation and shame. Indignation, because it is not right to accept evil and, even worse, to grow accustomed to evil, as if it were an inevitable part of the historical process. No! Without real indignation, without historical memory and without a commitment to learning from past mistakes, problems remain unresolved and keep coming back. We can see this these days in the case of war. The memory of the past must never be sacrificed at the altar of alleged progress."

"I feel shame—sorrow and shame—for the role that a number of Catholics, particularly those with educational responsibilities, have had in all these things that wounded you, in the abuses you suffered and in the lack of respect shown for your identity, your culture and even your spiritual values. All these things are contrary to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. For the deplorable conduct of those members of the Catholic Church, I ask for God's forgiveness and I want to say to you with all my heart: I am very sorry. And I join my brothers, the Canadian bishops, in asking your pardon. Clearly, the content of the faith cannot be transmitted in a way contrary to the faith itself: Jesus taught us to welcome, love, serve and not judge; it is a frightening thing when, precisely in the name of the faith, counter-witness is rendered to the Gospel." "...I will be happy to benefit again from meeting you when I visit your native lands, where your families live. So I will close by saying 'Until we meet again' in Canada..."
