PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ!

This week's Scriptures invite us to have an "Emmaus" Experience". Let us consider what is the meaning of Emmaus? Emmaus is a place just 7 miles away from Jerusalem Geographically. It's a place of human consolation and an unknown place of relaxation, where people wish to go when they are burnt out, hurt, humiliated or wish to distract or relax like a casino, resort or Hawaii or Las Vegas & etc. Emmaus is considered to be a quiet place where they could be by themselves recuperating from their pain and disappointment. Lk 24:35-48 speaks about the disappointment of the two disciples, who expected Jesus to be a great Political Leader and Liberator. But their hopes and dreams had been shattered and so they were disappointed. In order to avoid the situation and to escape the reality they were running for an unknown place where they could be by themselves.

With this background, I would like to explore the question of why do people leave the church? What are the reasons and how we could help them? Lifeway Research from the US studied this question and they wish to share their findings with us.

1.People have walked out of the church throughout our church history. People have been hurt, humiliated due to the scandals & corruptions. So, they have been disappointed with the Organized Institutional Church. People have walked out of the church due to shame, betrayal and sometimes our attitude towards others were naive.

2. 59% of the adults left the church due to the Change in their life and in the life of the Church. 19% of them left because they have become too busy to attend the church and their family priorities and responsibilities were overwhelming.

3.The major challenge was disagreement with the Pastor. About 37% of the people cited this reason for no longer attending the church. 17% of the people expressed that certain church members seem to be too nasty, critical and hurtful which prompted them to leave.

4.On the whole 80% of those who left the church expressed the view that they are Spiritual even though they do not belong to the Institutional Church. 14% of the people are of the view that the church does not promote and develop Spirituality. Therefore they left and lost faith in the Organized Religion. 16% of the people said that they are no longer welcome into the Church Environment because nobody has ever contacted & cared for them.

5. Some of the other reasons are indeed thoughtprovoking too.1. Dissatisfaction with the Pastor, Church Leaders, Councils, with the Church Programs, Ministry Opportunities. 2.Some felt isolated in the church. The Church seems to be Spiritually Abusive because spiritual needs are not met. Some are angry because the Latin Mass is no more.3. The traditional teachings of the Church on abortion, homosexuality, divorce, priestly celibacy, birth control, euthanasia and assisted dying etc. are no longer relevant to the modern mind, lament a large contingent. 4.The treatment of women is another contentious issue for people to leave the church. Finally, the church teaching on war, poverty and death penalty do not appeal to the modern minds because they are outmoded.

What's the Solution for these challenges? Jesus walked with the disappointed disciples and encouraged them through the Scriptures and Breaking of the Bread. Let us continually remember every one of the above challenges in our Sunday Liturgies invoking the good Lord to walk with us and Change the hearts that are hurt and resolve this situation. Let us become a welcoming Church with the mind and heart of Jesus!


