Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

Today we celebrate the glorification of Mary, the humble maid of Nazareth. She shared her life with Christ by participating in his birth, upbringing, suffering, death and resurrection. Now she shares his glory in heaven. Today we celebrate the crowning of Mary, Jesus' mother. We love and honor her not only because of her special role as the mother of our Redeemer, but also for her discipleship, her humble submission to God's call, an obedient child of God Almighty.

Pope Pius XII on Nov 1,1950 solemnly defined that the "Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory". We pause and reflect on the role of our Blessed Mother in the mystery of Salvation, for this provides the foundation for the belief in the Assumption. We firmly believe that from the first moment of her conception Mary was free of all sin, including Original Sin, by a special favor of Almighty God. During her lifetime, Mary always presented our Lord to others. She stood at the foot of the Cross of her Son, supporting Him and sharing His suffering through her love as only a mother could do.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians. The belief in the Assumption of our Blessed Mother has been long standing in our church. Christ took his flesh from the immaculate flesh of Mary, and if he had prepared a place in heaven for the Apostles, how much more for His Mother.

The belief that God took Mary to himself after her earthly life is based on the fact that even though she died like any other human, God in His goodness had blessed her to be with her Son in Heaven. Although the Bible does not explicitly mention the Assumption of Mary, there are Scriptural records of holy people like Enoch (Ge 5:24) and Elijah (2Kgs 2:1-11) were mysteriously taken into heaven with body and soul. Convinced of this truth of Mary's Assumption, Pope Pius XII, formally defined the dogma of the Assumption in 1950 and made it a statement of faith for the universal Church.

The Solemnity of Assumption gives us the Christian Hope that those who live and die in Christ will be united in Heaven with Mary, Holy Angels and Saints in glory. Mary consistently points us to Christ and to His good news. Therefore, we are called in our everyday humanity to listen and respond to God's Word, pointing to and orienting our lives towards the presence of Christ.

Recently the Global Catholic Climate Movement has changed its name to "Laudato Si' Movement" to better reflect its intentions and origin. Laudato Si' means Praise Be, the first words of St. Francis of Assisi's daily prayer "Praise Be to You, My Lord". It is also the title of Pope Francis's encyclical on care for creation. TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION—FOLLOW UP

On June 12th, approximately 70 parishioners met in the Parish Hall to dialogue on the concerns raised by the presence of the children buried on the grounds of the Kamloops Residential School. We are appreciative of the guidance of our facilitator, Debbie Hubbard, who helped us raise our questions and seek the truth that can lead to healing and reconciliation. An atmosphere of mutual respect pervaded the evening. Information about ongoing resources available in our area was distributed.

Many in the group expressed the need for further steps to learn, understand and move towards the healing of all who have been affected by this tear in the social fabric of our country and of our faith communities. At this point, the committee is suggesting the parish establish a small group study for those parishioners who wish to continue learning more about this issue. Some of the Canadian responses from the 2013 Truth and Reconciliation Document could be part of this study, and also some of the responses to that document from Catholic entities across the country.
