Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

Today's scriptures extend a call to be 'authentic Christians, inviting us to be Doers of the Word'. This message is further emphasized when Jesus Chastises the Pharisees for losing sight of the true spirit of faith and being judgmental hypocrites in their everyday life.

Hypocrisy is just acting or pretending to be what one is not. For example: Appearing to be great, virtuous and religious when one is not. Jesus tells us that such people only give 'lip service' to God but their hearts are far away from him. They pretend to worship him. But in fact, they worship idols (false Gods). Pope Francis elaborates saying such people do not rely on God, but they have recourse to witchcraft, star power, fortune telling machines or peoples and consult soothsayers. These are the false Gods we worship, explained the Pope.

Pure Religion is based on Love and Trust in the Almighty Power of God. Therefore, we should be sincere both in our intention and action and should not be appearing pious before the deity. Let us be truly pious, motivated by His great love for us.

It's obligatory to look after our parents and elders. We can't do away with this commandment and say that God will look after them. Certainly, God will look after them, but it is our prime duty to look after our parents, elders and those who depend on us. We should not and cannot say that what we intend to spend or use for the care of our parents, elders and vulnerable people, "I donate it to God", is just a white lie and a religious hypocrisy and escapism.

Religion is based on Love and not Legalism. 'Laws are

good, but love is better' says the Pope. Love should reign supreme, especially in religious circles, we need to promote love more than our attachment to law. Law should guide our outlook and deliberations. But love should prevail. Wherever and whenever possible, we employ the principle of love to manifest the

There's a sharp distinction between the 'Lip Religion, and, True Religion'. Our religiosity should spring from the heart and be expressed in our lips. Otherwise, it is a false religion. Therefore, Commandments are good and when adhered faithfully, they help to lead a dignified life in the presence of God. It should not be replaced by tradition. Let us not give in to vain glory. Let us live authentically following our faith with pure intentions that are manifested in actions.

NEW PILGRIM PATH






ANNOUNCEMENTS
