PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ!

Greetings in the Lord! Someone asked me to explain "Why the priest pours water into the Wine when he prepares the gifts at the Altar?"

"It was the Greek custom to add water into wine" explains Prof. Fr. Edward McNarma from the Pontifical University, Rome. The Romans adopted this practice when they ruled Palestine and passed on it to the Jewish people. Originally the Jewish never added water into wine.

There were pieces of evidence that Jesus himself had used wine tampered with water at the last supper as this was the common practice among the Jews and the Mediterranean culture.

St. Cyprian of 2nd Century A.D was able to affirm, "Wine is the Blood of Christ and Water is the People of God." As the water is mingled in the Wine, the People are made one in Christ. They have become inseparable.

When the Consecration takes place at the Altar of Sacrifice, 'Wine should be mingled with water'. It manifests the close union of God & humans. Pope Alexandar I wrote, "In the Lord's chalice neither wine only nor water only to be offered, but both mixed, because we read, "Blood and water flowed from his open side" (Jn19:34)

While mixing the wine with water, the priest prays, "By the mystery of this water & wine may we come to share in the divinity of Christ, who humbled himself to share our humanity".

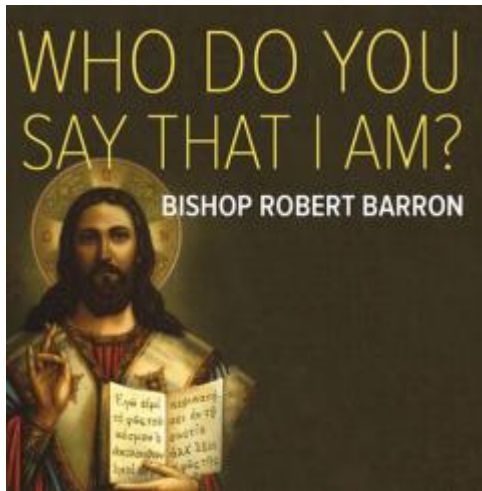

COLUMBARIUM



“Where you will be remembered”

The Columbaria Garden at St Charles Garner Church will be a resting place for the cremated remains of our parishioners and members of their families, and for members of other Kelowna Catholic parishes in the Nelson Diocese.

For centuries the highest honour that could be bestowed on an individual has been committal within a sacred place. For loved ones with a strong affiliation to our faith and our church, the assurance of a resting place on sacred ground provides personal and familial peace of mind.

St. Charles Garnier's Columbaria Garden will provide a secure, protective, enduring and peaceful place of honour for all of our loved ones.

A columbarium is a structure built from non-degrading materials with marine-grade aluminum niches, able to maintain their integrity and beauty in even the most punishing of environments. This structure is built with an exclusive ventilation system that circulates air throughout to eliminate any future problems.

The outer individual granite niche doors will open and close easily. A patented security system effectively protects the niches against forced entry and vandalism.

Each niche will be identified with a plate engraved into its granite face, to include the family name, Christian name, dates of birth and death of the deceased.

As shown on the renderings in the church entrance hall, the site for the columbaria garden will be located between the north and east side of St. Charles Garner church. This site will initially contain one columbarium with 80 niches, with accommodation for four additional columbaria (as required). It will be landscaped with trees and shrubs, surrounded by a wrought iron fence with a locked gate.

All required certificates and licensing approvals have been received from the Provincial Consumer Protection Branch in Victoria.

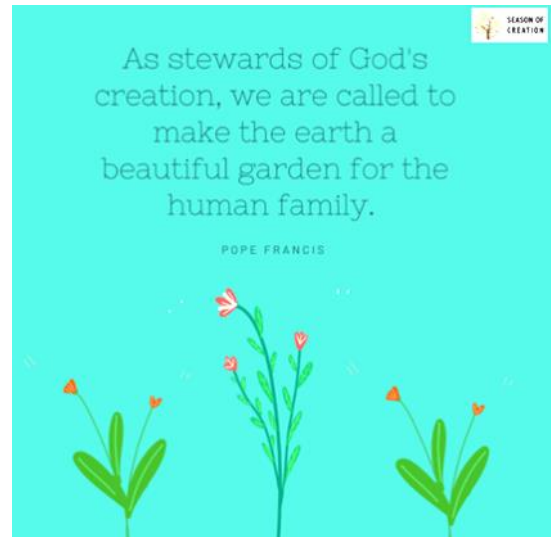
Construction will be completed in July 2020, with sales to begin shortly.
