PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ!

'Modern Cultural Shifts'

A variety of modern concepts & ideas like 'being attractive' to people both in body shape, dress, hair-style & etc; and people imitate or copy the lifestyle of their modalists to a greater extent to achieve this ideal. In the sports world, 'Young Sports Lovers' begin to develop the same type of dietary habits and engage in strenuous conditioning of their physical structure just like their Heroes. Most business entrepreneurs device novel methods to entice their customers such as the property brothers' location, location, and location.

A few days back someone asked a thought-provoking question in our Weekly Bible Study Session, "How can we make our church an attractive place for the faithful to participate in the liturgical services?" It was clear loud thinking and longing of those who practice their faith especially at this time of our life.

Most of our Worship sites are now reduced in size and number of participants for every service. Not many young adults are attending, no music, no fellowship, or special gatherings in our Church premises. In a way, there's an emptiness felt. 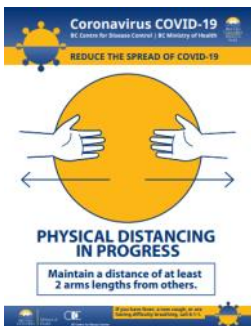
ANNOUNCEMENTS

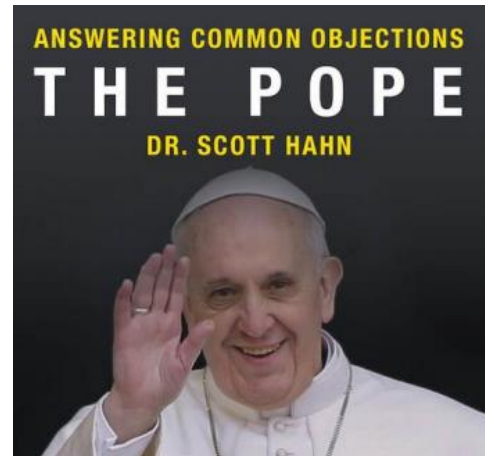

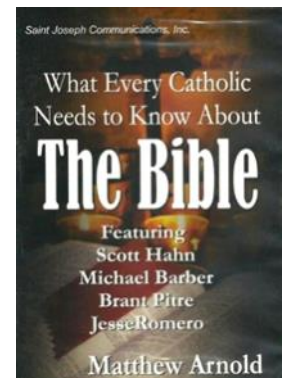
