Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ!

A few days back someone asked a thought-provoking question in our Weekly Bible Study Session, "How can we make our church an attractive place for the faithful to participate in the liturgical services?" 

What can we do to support our common home and the people with whom we share this amazing blue dot in the Universe? Here are two ideas:


- 1. Decorate your prayer space with a reminder of care of the Earth.
