PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

Jesus transformed the world by offering his Body & Blood for the nourishment of his believers. Jesus wishes to transform our World, and invites us to partner with him in this noble service, by sharing in the Eucharistic Banquet.

Eucharist is the Soul of our Christian Community. The Catechism of the Catholic Church # 1324 explains, "Eucharist is the summit and source of Christian life". It nourishes our spiritual life when we fully receive the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ in the consecrated bread and get strengthened to go about with our daily life & encounters.

The manna sustained the Hebrews for 40 years in the Wilderness. But they got tired of eating that food, as we say, 'familiarity breeds contempt'. The Divine Provision they received for 40 years became a pain and they despised it. Complaining to Moses they said, 'We loath this worthless food' (Nu 21:5) and rejected the manna (the food of the Angels). The manna manifested God's goodness and providence towards His children ministering in their critical crisis of foot shortage in the wilderness.

The Eucharist which is the Body and Blood of Christ is the True Food and Drink that the believer gets for his/her Eternal Life (Jn 6:55-56) Just as the manna sustained the Israelites on their journey to the promised land, the bread of life that Jesus offers, nourishes our soul in our daily struggle of life and strengthens us until we reach our Heavenly Home Land (Paradise/Heaven CCC 1391-1401)

As the human fetus is nourished in the womb of the mother, believers are nourished in the womb of the

Church, especially by the Sacrifice of the Altar. Just as the fetal growth needs nutrients, the spiritual growth of the believer needs the Eucharist. Pope John Paul II in the Document "Ecclesia De Eucharistia/ The Church of the Eucharist" wrote: Eucharist creates and builds the Church. It builds human communities. Celebration of the Eucharist vitalizes the Church. The Church grows as often as the sacrifice of the cross, (Christ our Pasch) is sacrificed.

Jesus said: "You are my friends" (Jn 15:14) When we enter into this deep relationship with Christ, we wish to participate in His Divine Life by the reception of the Eucharist. "He who eats me, will live because of me" (Jn 6:57) and we become inseparable with Christ when we receive Him in the Eucharist. Eucharist is a priceless gift and treasure. John Chrysostom wrote: "We who receive Him (Jesus) should become Jesus to others". Like Christ we should be motivated to transform our families and the known world through our selfless service and self-sacrificing love. In a gentle way Jesus shakes the world around us by our reception of His Body and Blood reminding us to do everything in remembrance of Him.

TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION—FOLLOW UP

On June 12th, approximately 70 parishioners met in the Parish Hall to dialogue on the concerns raised by the presence of the children buried on the grounds of the Kamloops Residential School. We are appreciative of the guidance of our facilitator, Debbie Hubbard, who helped us raise our questions and seek the truth that can lead to healing and reconciliation. An atmosphere of mutual respect pervaded the evening. Information about ongoing resources available in our area was distributed.

Many in the group expressed the need for further steps to learn, understand and move towards the healing of all who have been affected by this tear in the social fabric of our country and of our faith communities. At this point, the committee is suggesting the parish establish a small group study for those parishioners who wish to continue learning more about this issue. Some of the Canadian responses from the 2013 Truth and Reconciliation Document could be part of this study, and also some of the responses to that document from Catholic entities across the country. If you wish to explore this issue further by this means, please contact: 1. Sacramental preparation Classes for First Communion and Confirmation will begin from September. Parents who wish to enroll their children for these programs are requested to contact the Parish Office as soon as possible. If anyone wishes to help with these programs may speak to Fr. Gabriel.

2. Since the Corona Delta Variant seems to be spreading everywhere, we would like all our people to take necessary safety measures to prevent the spread of this Variant in our environment. Kindly follow the B.C Health protocols diligently.

3. The training materials for the Eucharistic Ministers and Ministers of the Word/Lectors are available in the Parish office. 
