PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and sisters,

"Entering God's Kingdom through the narrow door" (Lk 13: 23-24) is a 'simile' used by Jesus to explain the 'Pathway to Life or Eternal Life, Immortality and Paradise (the Promised Land and the Heavenly Kingdom) Jn 14:6 Tells that 'No one comes to the Father except through the Son'. Jesus is the Gate (Jn10:7-9), and all should enter through him following the principles of 'Love of God and Neighbour'. (The narrow gate is the principle with which God will bless us with eternity). It requires effort, focus, modification of attitude or behaviour to enter/ have access into such a door. It's not simple. We need to strenuously condition ourselves like the athletes in the arena. (ICor 9:24-27) in order to obtain this Divine Favor / Blessing.

Jesus gives us a great role model to imitate. 2 Cor 8: 9 "Jesus Christ was rich, but he became poor, in order to make us rich through his poverty". He divested himself of the glorious splendor of being God's Son and became a human in order to show us how to love one another. By this initiative, Jesus is inviting us to give up 'ego' and 'surrender' to God as He himself surrendered to God's plan. He became the plenitude of love. Like Christ we are invited to develop a burning Love for our family and friends. 2 Cor 5:14 Calls for this 'Overwhelming Love' (Love of Christ Urges to commit for Love).

Genuine Love should be our hunger & thirst for Christ and His people with Jesus' Compassion and Mercy (Lk 6:36) Christian Charity gives a concrete expression of our Union with other Christians.

Entering the Narrow Gate/Door is entering the Promised Land/Heaven. Eternal Life is gained/achieved only by the grace of Jesus (Jn 14:6)

"No one comes to the Father except through me". Therefore, we are reminded of Deepening our faith in Christ. Acts 4:10-12 "Only the Name of Jesus saves" (There's no other name in the whole world that grants eternal life except the Name of Jesus). Therefore, we are encouraged to hear the Word of God and Believe it. Don't reject the Word. Let not the Word fall on deaf ears. Hear the Word and act on it. It will transform you into a 'New Being'/ New Creation in Christ. (2 Cor 5:17)

We are encouraged to engage in Charitable activities. Using the material goods, we can also make a difference in life, because 'charity absolves multitude of sins'. This is understood as gathering riches for the kingdom of God. But we need to do it discreetly without any fanfare. Mt 6: 4 Reminds: "The Lord who observes our good deeds in secret, will Reward us". Eternal life is achieved by all believers who adhere to these principles of Christ and those who have washed their robes in the Blood of the Lamb and not just the 144000 as it is spoken of in the book of Revelation 7:1-8. Be hopeful to meet in the abode of God in Eternity!

At the end of the Season an Outdoor Mass in praise of God's beautiful creation in all its many forms will be celebrated October 2nd @ 2:00 pm at the Stations of the Cross behind the Pastoral Centre.

On Tuesday October 4th, the feast of St. Francis, please bring your small pets, either in carriers or on leash to the front entranced of the church for a blessing by Father Gabriel at 2:00 pm.
