PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ!

"True Prayer is Born of the Heart" (Ps 130:1) This week's Scriptures invite us to ponder this concept from the background of CCC # 2559 "Humility is the Foundation of Prayer". St. Augustine further explained, 'We stand before the Almighty as beggars seeking His Blessings'. True humility is humbling ourselves before the Deity. It's not being haughty. Haughty is showing great pride, whereas humility is modest, lowly and unpretentious. Therefore, an invitation is extended to all to consider practicing this virtue "Humility"... (No boasting or Exalted Behaviour in the presence of the deity at any time) David, the Great King of Israel, humbled himself at the 'Presence of the Ark of the Covenant' and leaped / danced joyfully singing explains Psalm 68. Like David, the Church invites us to humble ourselves before the Presence of Christ, present in the Tabernacle and Leap / Sing to Him Joyfully.

The Israelites frequented Mount Zion. It's from here they received the 10 Commandments. But in life, they never were faithful to the Covenant as they often disobeyed and went after other gods. But God went after them showing mercy and benevolence. We, the New Israelite people Redeemed by the Blood of Christ, Come into Jesus' Presence every Lord's Day / Sunday with our minds made pure to leap / sing, out of gratitude for what God has done to us through the Blood of Jesus. It's with our humble posture we approach the throne of grace.

Luke 14:1, 7-14 Explains our Church Etiquette. When we come to the Church for Worship, we are in the 'Awe Inspiring Presence of Jesus'. In our Social Gatherings / Fellowship / Banquet, special or prominent places or seats are allotted to dignitaries.

But in our Church Etiquette, we can choose our own seats and we could be seated with whomsoever we wish. We are children of God and God treats every one of us as His Special. We choose our places in God's table and He ministers to everyone equally, spreading a bounteous table with finest wine and richest food. (Is 25:6) We are fed here with His Body & Blood.

In our Social Fellowship / Banquet, we spend our quality time only with those who we have invited. Whereas, at God's table God spends His time with every one of us as we are precious to Him. We come here to spend quiet time with Him to confide our aches and pains, joys and merriments to the Divine. "God listens to our broken hearts" (Ps 34;18) The Sparrow and the Swallow have found favour in the House of the Lord and We His Children should be able to find greater love from our God. God extends his Divine courtesy to everyone who comes into His Presence.

St. Paul in Phil 2:5 Talks about 'imitating Christ'. In our Church Etiquette. We are encouraged to imitate Christ incorporating His style of serving. Jesus welcomed all, irrespective of their social, cultural, ethnic and economic backgrounds. He was never prejudiced. He reached out to all and never excluded anyone. He was never haughty, but was outgoing. He was a bridge builder. He had several challenges, but he went out of himself to connect even with those who were very critical of him. He never neglected them from his interaction and was not discouraged by their criticism. He always found something best from every hostile / critical thought. But Jesus always did His Father's Will through His Discernment. So, today's Scriptures invite us to change our attitudes and begin to think 'Outside of the Box' to do a world of good for the Love of God and our Community by imitating Him.




HOSPITAL MINISTRY
