PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers & Sisters in the Lord!

'Faith' is the ability to believe. When we develop 'Steadfast love & Trust' in the other (especially in the marriage covenant, business dealings and personal relationships like friendship with individuals & groups and so on) In our Religious understanding, 'Faith' would mean. "My God is near me", because the Hebrew Word for Faith is 'EMUNAH' that gives the meaning "Support". Therefore, Faith is the Lord's support, because the Almighty is working in every situation and circumstance of the humans. Paul in Romans 10:9 Explains, "Jesus is the Christ and God Raised Him from the Dead", is the Core of our Christian faith. Paul recommends that every believer is encouraged to profess this faith. (We should confess this faith with our lips and believe it in our hearts). Rm 1:17 also reminds, "The just live by faith alone / The upright / Righteous person finds life through Faith".

Faith comes from the belief that Jesus died and rose again. This faith builds up a deep and intimate friendship & relationship with the Divine. Example: Abraham believed in God and it was reckoned to him (Ge 12:1-2) God said to Abram, 'Leave your country, your family and your father's house, for the land I will show you'. (Hebrews 11:8-12 explains how Abraham & Sarah trusted the Lord) Ge 15:6 "Abram put his faith in God, who counted this as making him justified". Therefore, Faith can be the Guarantee of the Blessings that we hope for and it was for Faith that our ancestors were commended.

(You may also refer to Ex 14:1-31 7 Ephesians 2:8-9 & Daniel 3: 17-18)

Given to the Believer, To Gain His Freedom and Forgiveness through Faith" (Ephesians 2:6-9) We are indeed saved by His Blood. This gift is freely given / gratuitously bestowed on everyone who seeks Him with a Sincere /Genuine Heart. Faith is cultivated and strengthened by the Word of God (Reading and Reflection of the Scriptures) and Nurtured by our Frequent Reception of the Sacraments, through the participation of the Sacramental Life of the Church.

Paul in Galatians 5:6 Wrote : "Faith should be reflected in our Love" (Faith should make its power felt through love) Faith is to be expressed in our Charity & in our charitable works or deeds. (This is called living faith / transformative faith) Living Faith transforms us into 'New Beings / New Creatures or New Creation" (2 Cor 5:14) Genuine Faith should impel us with good actions especially to roll up our sleeves for actions to connect with the less fortunate brothers and sisters especially the migrants, refugees, homeless and the alienated from social and cultural interactions. We are having this 'extraordinary power' (2 Cor 5:7) hidden in our hearts, minds, thoughts and souls. We need to activate this faith to bear fruit to walk extra miles and to make a difference, to build bridges of friendships and also to demolish the walls of hatred. (Faith without works is futile / dead' Let us also have the option for the poor and the marginalized. (James 2:17) May God help us in this initiative!

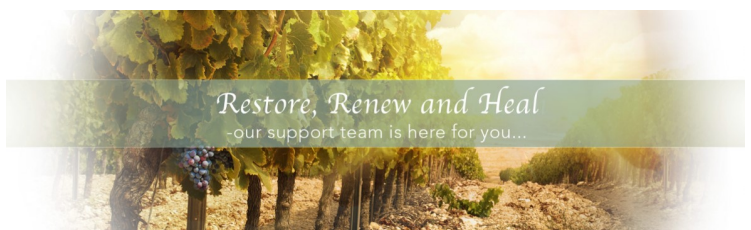

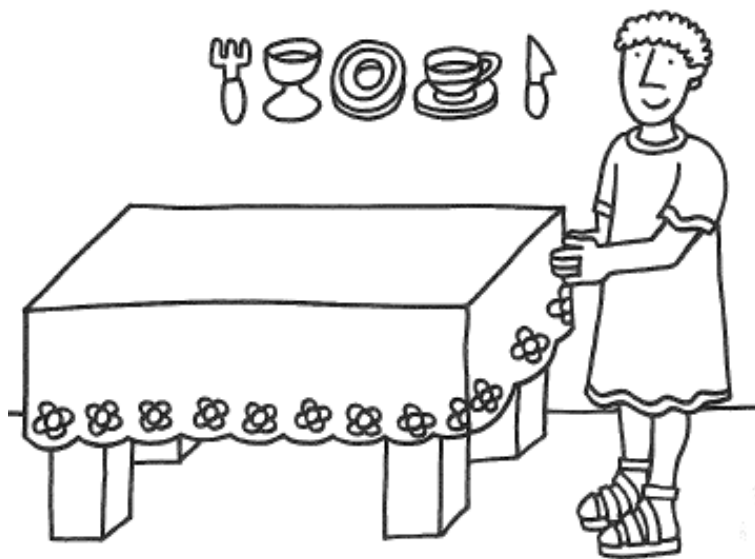
