PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

"Rejoice in the Lord always, and again I say Rejoice!". (Phil4:4)

'Joy is born of the heart'. Sigmund Freud, the Father of Modern Psychology explains that there are 2 dominant emotions that rule every human 'Joy & Sorrow'. Joy is always associated with the Birth of a Baby, first employment, first love & first venture. Sorrow is a compelling emotion felt when we lose our loved ones (parents, siblings, friends or those whom we esteemed), loss of reputation especially when someone falls from prosperity to poverty.

Joy comes to God's faithful when we reflect/ponder the mighty acts of God in our life. With an attitude of gratitude, we always remember the saving actions of God in our life. We weep aloud / quietly in our heart cherishing the pleasant moments that God has given us, especially when someone is saved from a lifethreatening accident or malignant disease. We experience the 'abiding presence of God' in such moments. We automatically fall on our knees with gratitude and weep in the presence of God overwhelmed with Joy for His saving grace & mercy. Joy comes to us when our hearts are full.

Virgin Mary is the Recipient of God's Grace. Angel Gabriel addressed her "Hail, full of Grace/ Rejoice, so highly favored". (Lk1:28) Mary received the full flow of God's favor. Therefore, she pondered / deeply reflected (Lk 2:51) the wonderful kindness of God in her life, i.e. 'the virginal birth of Christ, which is Incarnation' (The Eternal Word becoming a Human Being) She treasured that pleasant moment and ruminated all her life. We ordinarily express our Joy, having dessert, wine, food, dancing, singing, throwing up things in the air and also sharing our company with friends and family. Today the Church invites us to share the Joy of the 'Expectant Mother Mary and Rejoice with her for the gift of New life. Therefore, Joy is both Emotional and Spiritual.

Emotional because it makes the person happy, stronger, greater and it is a personal experience such as winning an Olympic medal/prize, Crossing the Niagara Falls, going to the Space Station or Surviving a Holocaust & so on. Joy is Spiritual because it is the gift of the Spirit. It is the sharing of the favor of God. God has shown benevolence and mercy to someone and blessed him/her with His goodness like success in life, good health, new relationship, a new parent and so on. We become the recipients of God's Grace and Benevolence. The Birth of Christ spreads this Joy. The Spirit of Jesus spreads Joy and Peace among those who listen to him. Such people share the Messianic Joy. Let us share the Joy of the Messiah always. "Bride meeting the Groom" (Zeph 3:14-18) Joy is born of the heart! Joy comes when the heart is full.



At the hour of death call me.


