Almighty God Extends His Hands to the Humans!

This week's Scriptures help us understand the Fatherly Love of God. Like a loving dad/parent, God extends his hands to reach out to the humans when we pass through challenging times in our life. The best picturesque example is Michael Angelo's drawing on the Sistine Chapel in the Vatican - Rome. This world-famous picture explains God's Love and Mercy in a creative way and helps perceive His amazing steadfast love and care. God reaches out to the humans.

This coming week we will celebrate God's Mercy through Sacramental Reconciliation in our parish. God extends his grace and mercy to his children to purify themselves to welcome him into their life and to our world. The Power of the Holy Spirit purifies, cleanses our heart, mind and soul in order to become worthy of Him. The Holy Spirit empowers us to become fit for the indwelling of God and makes us His Temple. Michael Angelo's famous piece of art has a great impact on the believers and also on the world at large, 'God Reaches out extending His Hand'.

The Prophet Baruch (582 B.C) was a Secretary of Prophet Jeremiah. He explained the distress of the Hebrew people and gave them the Hope that God will be their source of redemption if they were able to seek His Mercy. He also said that God would 'Intervene on their behalf and Restore them to their Original Glory'. He will accompany them in their life. Therefore 'Repentance' is our 'New Exodus' leading across another Sinai desert to a New and more Glorious Promised Land (Is 41:17-20) of prosperity and plenty.

The Evangelist Luke describes this passage as a wilderness or desert experience which helps us share the passion and death of Christ, leading us to the Promised Land.

This privilege is gained through Jesus' Resurrection. We share in the Resurrection of Christ through our Baptism and enter into the promised land. Repentance provides us with that ability to become sharers of God's Grace & His Kingdom.

Today's liturgy therefore explores the possibility of our Creative ways and intelligence (like the 'Chinese Ice City' built on Ice blocks every year, but has a lasting impact on the World around) benefitting from the grace of God's reaching out to us. During these days of Advent, how can we be able to prepare to receive Christ, the Messiah to be born in our human world. In the busyness of the World we are caught up with the consumerist culture that reaches out with their creative endeavors like toys, lights, costumes and desserts. Can the Christian faithful explore Creative Ways of Reaching out to their Sisters and Brothers to make this Great Goodnews of Christ, the Messiah's Birth available to their families and friends around the World?

WHAT IS ADVENT

Pope Benedict explained 'advent is a time in which we experience the Presence of Eternity and eagerly await its arrival'. It's a time of Joy, an interior joy that no suffering can snatch or take away. It's a joy which we carry within us, giving us courage to continue forward into the future with confidence. Therefore 'advent' is translated as, presence, arrival and coming', says the Pope. We pause in silence to 'behold & understand this presence'. Technically the term 'advent' indicates the arrival of an Official, or visit of the King, or Emperor to a Province. It is celebrated during this season for the "Coming of the Divinity". Christians used the word 'advent' to express their relationship with Christ". Jesus the King entered the poor Province called the Earth, to visit with the Humankind.

Hebrews 13:8 "Jesus Christ is the same, yesterday, today and forever". Advent is a call to experience the Presence of God in Human History. It extends an invitation to 'Journey with the Divine'. During these days of grace, we relive the 'hopes and dreams of the ancient Israelite people' who journeyed with the Divine for the Birth of the Messiah. They were drawn to the grandeur of Mt. Zion where they experienced the Glory of God. The Prophet Elijah saw God's glory in this mountain. Every person and nation gathered at Mt. Zion perceived the majesty of God revealed in that mountain. The mountain of God became the goal of all the Nations in ancient times.

For us, advent is a period of "Eager Expectation" to make a hope filled journey in the foot-steps of Christ. We are encouraged to be 'Active Participants and just the Passive Recipients of this Hope". We are invited to make a New Beginning with Mother Mary, as she Rejoices with Christ". We reflect on God's initiative to come among us through the cooperation of a Human Mother called Mary, and with her consent, God, who is the Word, becomes Human. Because of this wonderful gift of life, the young Mother Mary Rejoices, and we join with her these days with our own eager expectation to 'Behold the face of God', in the Baby Jesus', says Bishop Gerald Wiesner OMI.
