PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Sacred Liturgy / Celebration of the Sunday Liturgy

The Constitution of Sacred Liturgy (Chapter 1, #10) defines "Sacred Liturgy is the Summit and Source toward which the activity of the Church is directed". Liturgy is not a spectacle to be observed but a prayerful event where Christians Encounter Christ's presence in their lives, Pope Francis said.

Throughout the Catholic Church's long history, people have been tempted to practice a private or "intimist Christianity" that failed to recognize the importance of the liturgy in Spiritual life, the Pope said Feb. 3 during his weekly audience. However, "I would dare say that Christianity without Liturgy is a Christianity without Christ", he said.

Continuing his series of talks on Prayer, the Pope reflected on the significance of the liturgy in Christian life. While there are certain forms of Spirituality in the Catholic Church 'that have failed to adequately integrate', the Pope noted that "much has been achieved in recent decades", particularly thanks to II Vat Council's Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy.

Encounter Christ who is "not an idea or sentiment, but a living person." Along with Sacred Scripture and the Sacraments, the liturgy "may not be dispensed with because in Christ Jesus, it became a way of Salvation." Therefore, there is no Christian spirituality that is not rooted in the Celebration of the Holy mysteries," the Pope said.

The Mass or Divine Liturgy, he continued, is the Spiritual act of the heart of "the whole Christian experience" because Jesus makes himself present and "gives himself to his faithful." Christians who participate in

the Mass, he added, are not, "spectators of something that slips away without involvement" but instead are active participants who celebrate it "through the diversity of gifts and ministries."

Christians are called to transform their lives into an act of worshipping God, "but this cannot happen without prayer, especially Liturgical Prayer." When we go to Mass, We go to pray in the Community, We go to pray with Christ who is present, who is next to you." The Sacred Constitution also informs in #25 "Out of gratitude for the Body and Blood of Christ, those who have received Communion should spend at least some time in Prayer".

Cardinal Sarah in his recent address recommends on Sacred Liturgy, people in the pews are encouraged to be quiet/silent after the Mass providing space for those who may be able to spend time in prayer. I discussed with our Bishop, the Chief Liturgist of the Diocese, in my recent meeting about our clapping after each Weekend Services. Bishop is of the opinion that it needs to be communicated to everyone that it goes against the "Spirit of the Liturgy".

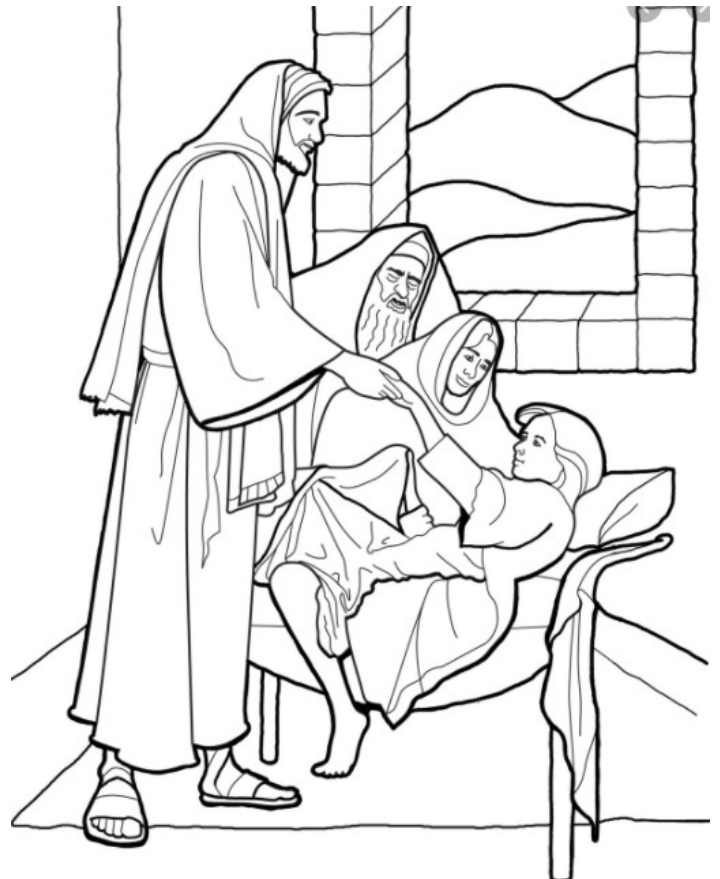
