PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters & Brothers in the Lord!

Christian Discipleship is Exciting and Demanding. This week's Scriptures break open this message very clearly. It is exciting because we share Christ's mandate 'to go out to all the world and share the good news'. We share the mission of Christ through our Baptismal Commission. It is challenging because it is too demanding. It requires radical commitment and a solid transformation. St. Paul in Romans 12:2 explained, "Don't be conformed to the World but be transformed". So, it needs a lot of courage and optimism to be focused on the goal/result.

Disciples are Companions & partners of Jesus in His mission. They are recruited from a variety of backgrounds forming a multicultural group to minister to the multicultural society with a variety of professional skills. Some are from the upper class or elites. Some have no social status at all. Yet some others are identified as ordinary and middleclass people. Surprisingly some are from the radical backgrounds. The College of the twelve that Jesus selected reflect this short summary of the group.

Jesus extended an invitation "Come follow me" and gave a task-oriented mission, "I will make you fishers of people" (Mk1:17-19) We understand that fishing is a leisure time activity in the modern world for many. But fishing was a lucrative business during Jesus' time and even today it is a major economic drive in the modern world. Therefore, it's a full-time activity occupying one's complete focus and undivided attention. Fishing requires skill, patience and time. either a windstorm or capsizing of the boat in the whirlwind or in the middle of a pirate attack.

I am definite that this is how the missionary journey of the Disciple is envisioned. Certainly, missionary life is not the bed of roses. It's not the bed of thorns either.

The Four first disciples of Christ are fishermen, namely Peter, Andrew, John and James. They were well seasoned by the winds and waves of the sea. Jesus at the outset, laid the ground for discipleship that the one who wished to follow him should be 'shaped by his/her own life's skills and challenges to become an effective witness of the master's mission'. The first disciples give us a foretaste of their lifestyle. They had a lucrative business and a family to care for. But Jesus' call to discipleship demanded a Transformation. It was a remarkable transformation in the lives of the first disciples to give up their business, family, comfort zone and the income to go after Christ. It was too demanding but they were willing to start a 'New Life' with the penniless preacher, Jesus, and it was too demanding. Jonah's story helps us understand why he was trying to escape God's invitation to be sent out to Nineveh. He certainly did not like it and so he wished to escape from God. But God had other plans to make him to do His work. It was so compelling and he obeyed. God taught him a good lesson to obey Him.

Therefore, discipleship is a calling. We are called to be Jesus' followers from the day of our Baptism. God calls all sorts of people from several walks of life. The main purpose of His call is to build up a deep relationship with Him. To become companions of Jesus in the journey of life and to radiate his goodness to everyone. Canadian multiculturalism is a great opportunity to explore the possibility of serving God's people in different situations. Mother Theresa was of the opinion that we share the mission of Christ through our humble service to our friends and family especially when we share and care for the poor, marginalized and the ostracized people of our world. We are His disciples if we are able to respond to His call.

May the good Lord give us vision to participate in His Mission.
