PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

"Lord Send us Shepherds after Your Heart" is the prayer that we are prompted to make today as we read and reflect this week's Scriptures. The analogy of 'shepherd and flock' builds up a mutual personal relationship. The shepherd is bound to his flock by a devotion to which corresponds the confidence of the sheep. Therefore, shepherding is understood as 'governing, leading, pasturing and sanctifying' in our Church terminology. Prophets Jeremiah 23:1-6 and Ezekiel 31: 1-31 use this metaphor to explain how Israelite leaders failed God's people during their time in office. Shepherds looked into their comforts and interests. They fed themselves at the expense of the needs of their flock. Instead of supporting them in their challenges the shepherds just deserted them leaving their sheep to be devoured by hostile forces.

The Book of Prophet Jeremiah clearly points out the failure of the Modern Church practices. The Sunday Missalette of today reports: "The shepherds with the responsibility for many of the public institutions such as, 'Religion and Government' seem to have been motivated by greed and hunger for power rather than concern for common good. Saddest of all is this, that the surge of violence in the World, the abuse within the churches have pushed many to leave disheartened, disillusioned and unable to trust anyone in leadership role. Therefore, Jeremiah uses the harsh words, "Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture." Therefore, God takes the lead to promise His sheep that He will Save, He will Lead and He Will Feed them in fertile fields.

Good leaders seek the interest of others before feeding themselves. They imitate the 'good shepherd' (Jesus). Shepherding is an office fundamentally leading to servanthood that requires genuine care for the wellbeing of those in their care. Managing people is not about power trips or holding one's authority over others. Rather, it is a godly and righteous supervision seeking to ensure that people in their care are flourishing. Godly people do it out of love for God and not for gain, fame, or popularity. Pope Francis is a great role model of shepherding when he says, 'go to the peripheries of your parish/diocese'. Paul wrote in Co 3:20 "Whatever your task, put yourself into it, as done for the Lord and not for your masters."

Paul in Ephesians 2:13-18 assures that God in Christ will never abandon the believer, who has become a 'righteous branch' in the household of David, which is the New Christian Community. Christ Jesus is our Peace, the One who breaks down the dividing wall of hostility, power, authority and control that exists among us. Jesus has invited us into his friendship. We have become a New Creation and when felt crushed and helpless because of neglect, party-spirit, sectarianism violence and abusive situations...let us not get away and desert the Lord. Rather, let us turn to the Lord Jesus, Our Good Shepherd and Peace maker to Seek His Divine Intervention. Jesus said: "Lean from me for I am gentle and humble in heart". So, let us unload all our worries and anxieties onto His feet. So that he may be able to shepherd us to rich and green pastures all our life and beyond.
