PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ!

This week's Scriptures invite us to express our Christian faith in action. Our Christian calling impels us to express our Faith, Hope and Love. Faith of a Christian is a 'gift of God' and it is initiated in our Baptism. Pope Francis states that Mother Mary is the best example to look up to, when we consider, how we could put our faith into practice. She lived out this Christian calling profoundly by visiting her elderly cousin Elizabeth. This is how 'faith works through love' explained Pope Francis. She walked an extra mile to visit with her elderly relative. Therefore, love shared is multiplied even in our lives when we try to practice it.

Paul in Ephesians 4:1-6 advises everyone to lead a life, worthy of the calling that we have received at our Baptism. Faith in Jesus began when we heard the good news, and made a personal commitment, that Jesus is the Messiah, Son of God! This faith is not simply an intellectual assent, but a vital force, a commitment to the person of Jesus and His saving works. We nurture our faith and get rooted in Him through our works. There we are reminded by the Lord to express our faith in Love, Charity and Service. Paul in Gal 5:12 wrote: "Practice good deeds of love & Show to others". 'Serve one another in love', since the whole law is summarized in a simple commandment, "Love one another as I have loved you".(Mt 22:34-38).

The Apostle John in his 1st letter 3:18 wrote: "Let not your love be only in words and speeches, but let it be expressed in service and in action". In short, let our actions speak louder than our words. Let our living faith be expressed, in our simple gestures as enumerated in Ephesians 4:1-6 such as practicing humility, gentleness, patience and so on. So that we would be able to bear 30,60 & 100% fruits. Get planted and rooted in Christ the Lord! Let us make a difference by walking extra miles, and stepping forward to do good works like Mother Theresa and John Paul II. If we do this, we would emphatically proclaim as Paul did in Gal 2:20 " I live, not I but Christ lives in me. The life I live, I live by faith, faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself up for me". Our Christian manner of life is a wonderful commitment to Jesus. When we practice our faith, it becomes vibrant and attracts others also to follow our way of life.


