PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers & Sisters in the Lord!

The Scriptures of this week invite us to thank God for our Treasures. "Where your Treasure is, there will your heart be" reminds Lk 12:34. We are also cautioned by Mt 6:19-21 "Do not store up treasures for yourselves on earth, where moths and worms destroy and thieves can break in and steal. But store up treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor woodworms destroy them and thieves cannot break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart is also". So, we are encouraged to explore 'What exactly is a treasure or what do we mean by a treasure?'

Treasure is the accumulated wealth or stored wealth in terms of riches like money, jewels, precious stones, valuable records and so on. People hunt /search for hidden treasures. Our early settlers were searching for silver, gold and diamonds in Canada. Once they found a treasure, they began to excavate, store and market them for financial gain. In fact, they wished to build up a fortune and leave behind a legacy to their family especially to their grandchildren. Therefore, the expression, there are people born with a 'silver spoon in their mouth'. These are born with riches, possessions and wealth. Some are born with large ancestral inheritance like estates, yet some others are born in aristocracy with prosperous backgrounds.

Onlookers consider these people as fortunate. These people create an impression among their peers and friends who call them people of importance, status, wealth, privileged, powerful and influential. May God bless these individuals and their families.

But we also need to explore the concept of people becoming great. Alexander Solzhenitsyn wrote in one of his novels, "We prove our greatness not by our wealth, possessions, power, prestige, privilege or influence, but by the grandeur of our actions. Our timely actions make us great; our moral actions make us great, our sensitivity to human needs make us incredible people. Shakespeare in his 'Merchant of Venice' wrote, "All that glitters is not gold". Therefore, he advised not to be carried away by the appearances of people.

The Church today wishes to teach about our role in 'building up our human society', especially our 'families' through our timely care and sharing of our resources who are in need. 'This is our moral obligation'. Let us make a difference with kindness and gentleness and not to give in to indifference and apathy. Let us think of others who need our timely help and support and come forward to share our riches gladly, especially our joy, goodwill and try our best to esteem everyone as a treasure so precious in our life. Let us not forget that "we all carry Jesus, the treasure in our earthen vessels". (2 Cor 4:7)

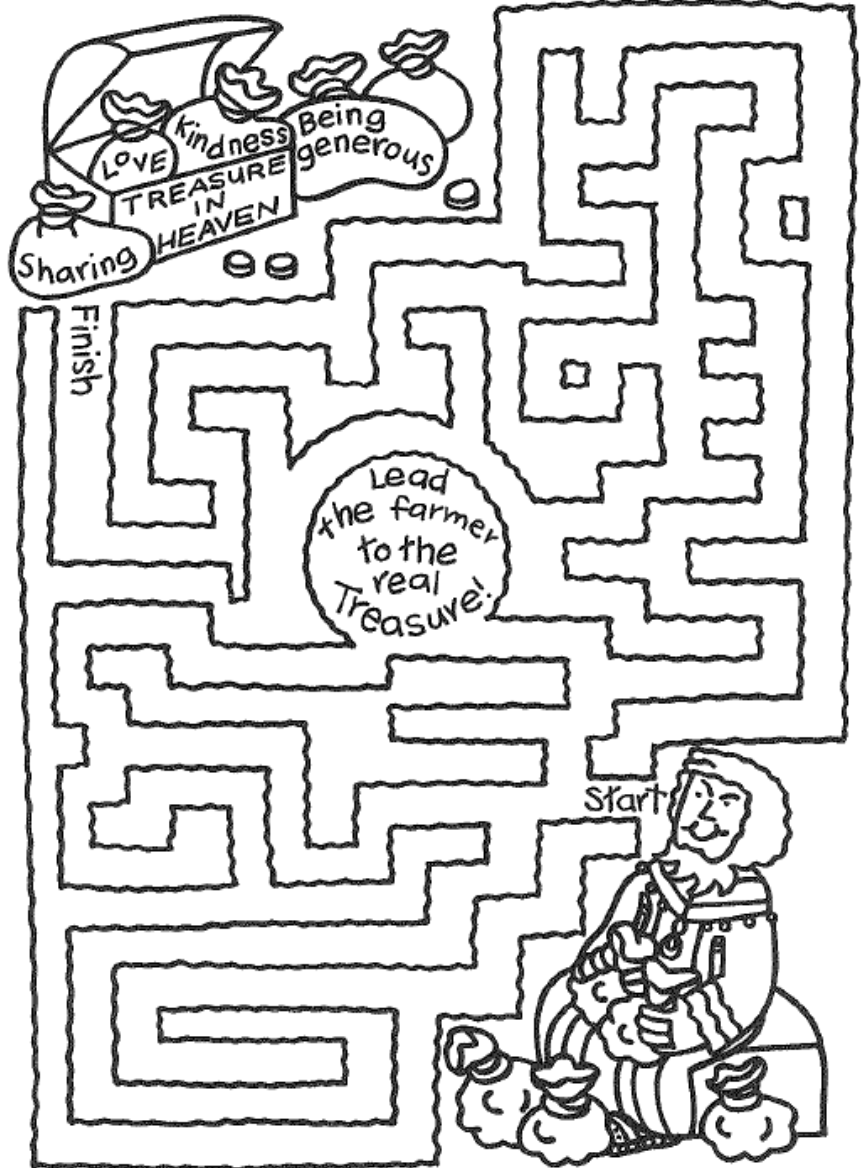


How many carrots can this farmer fit in his barn?
