### PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord!

This week's Scriptures extend a call to actualize our 'Christian Experience'. The letter to the Romans 14:7 -8 helps us with this concept: "If we live, We live for the Lord, if we die, We die for the Lord. So that alive or dead, We belong to the Lord". It's a joy to be with Christ all through our life because 'we carry the marks of Jesus Christ in our bodies' (Gal 6:17) The marks of Christ are 'His Sacred Wounds'. The scars, the stigmata and the tattoos of Christ and we bear them in life, when we participate in his suffering and death. In the ancient World, animals had been marked/branded as the property of someone. In a Spiritual sense, Christian people are ever branded as his Slaves, Servants, Friends and Companions with the markings of Christ. (Rm1:1 & Gal 1:10)

The markings come from the "Christ Event" especially from His suffering and death. Our Christian experience is sharing in the 'Suffering of the master' especially so, when we suffer with illness (2 Cor 12:7) floggings (2 Cor 11:25) and affliction (2Cor 1:8) In today's Scripture Paul wishes to invite us to boast with him: "May I never boast of anything except the Cross of Christ (Gal 6:14) for I carry the marks of Christ Jesus in my body". (Gal 6:17)

What are the marks of Christ and How do we carry them in our mortal bodies? There are five marks of Christ:

1.Sweat of Blood (MK 14:32-42, Mt 26:36-46 and Lk 22:39-46) When he was in the Garden of Gethsemane, 'his sweat fell to the ground like drops of blood'. When our life's burdens become unbearable and un -shareable, we too sweat blood. Psalm 34:18 Explains, "God listens to the cry of our soul" especially when we are having mental and physical tight corners. They stir us to sweat. From page 1...

Our panic leads to despair, anguish and agony and we roll in pain sweating blood.

2. Wound from Thorns: (MK 15:16-20) The soldiers twisted some thorns into a crown and put it on his head. They struck him, spat on him and mocked him kneeling down as if doing homage. Mt 27:27-331 also adds that the soldiers stripped him and fooled him as the king of the Jews. Indeed, they disfigured Jesus, degrading his dignity and honor. Similarly, our honor is disfigured by calumnies, uncharitable criticisms or harsh comments, implied meanings, naive and nasty remarks and negativities of all sorts.

3. Wounds from the Scourging: (Mt 27:26 & Mk 15:15) Pilate ordered Jesus to be scourged and then handed over to be crucified". But in Luke we have a different version 23:18 "Pilate ordered him to be flogged and let him go "in the first instant, but he quickly changed his opinion when the crowd became unruly, Lk 23:24 "Pilate consented to the crowd and gave Christ to be crucified". (Out of fear for his position) Sometimes, we are unable to stand our ground like Pilate and we change our opinions, even though we know what is right and just. But we don't have the guts to affirm the truth. Jesus received 40 beatings, less one (39 laces as per the Roman custom) They broke his bones, flesh and spirit. In fact, they reduced his life by their inhumane treatment. We too, do the same through our "Apathy and Indifference' and wear people out oftentimes. We reduce others' personality and character by our unwanted comments, uncharitable thoughts words and actions.

4. Wounds from the Nails: Lk 3:33 "They crucified him with two other criminals on either side". Mt 27:36 "They finished crucified him". Mt 27:39-44 "The passer-by jeered at him and mocked him". Mt 27:44 "Even the robbers who were crucified with him taunted him". Nails controlled the Physical Jesus. Power and control of the Jewish elders and people in positions controlled him by the deep driven nails. Do we not also control our vulnerable people by our power and control? Don't we often rob people of their individuality and freedom through our power, control and authority?"

5. Wounds from the spear: Jn 19:34 "One of the soldiers pierced his lance into Jesus' chest". How do we pierce others or break open their privacy and malign? Hearts are broken either by love failure or break of relationship or children running away from home, financial loss, reversal of fortune and falling from glory to misery. By our weakness & frailty we inflict wounds on others. Hardships of life compel us to carry these marks in our heart and soul. In all these and similar situations we experience the vulnerability of our human condition like Christ. Let us allow God's plan to prevail as Jesus allowed his Father's plan to prevail. In all these our faith should motivate us to live our Christian commitment bearing the marks of Christ. No turning back despite the challenges faced. Like St. Paul, let us learn to suffer for Christ (2 Cor 11:23-33). May God give us grace!


