PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and sisters in the Lord! Today's Scriptures invite us to reflect on the theme of "Our Christian Calling". Galatians 5:1 Tells, "For Freedom we are Called". Therefore, Christian Life is a privilege, a gift from God. It is a call to Holiness. It should not lead us towards Godless Conduct at any time. Through our Baptismal Grace we become Sons and Daughters of God. This Baptismal Grace initiates Holiness in every one of us 'to know God, love God and abide in God'. (Jn1:12,39 & 1Jn 5) Christian life has an aim: a) to know Christ b) to be found in His Love (Phil 2:18)

Christian Life has a purpose: a) to love & honor God and b) to love our people (Mt 22:34-38) Christian life has a goal: a) to reach heaven b) to see God face to face (Mt 25:31-46) Christian Life is therefore based on certain values: a) to accept everyone unconditionally b) to treat everyone with respect & dignity (non-judgemental attitude) and c) to encourage everyone to accommodate others in our company especially those with whom we have hostility and differences / who are considered to be enemies / who do not share our values.

Christian life is not based on 'status, power, privilege & position. But it is based on goodwill. 'Walking extra miles, building bridges & not walls, extending a helping hand or an Olive Branch to those who need us. It's ultimately making a difference in life like Christ our Lord & Master. Christ taught us to Love & Serve (Mt 22:37) "You must love your God with all your heart, soul and mind". Jesus also told us in Mt 22:39 & "You must love your neighbour as yourself" and in Leviticus 19:18 We read, "You must love your neighbour as yourself". Therefore Christian calling hinges on these Two Salient Features of Christ's Teachings: "Love of God & Neighbour".

Pope Francis teaches 'to have tolerance towards others' (not to be too critical of others / practice leniency towards others) Christian Freedom should help us to Love & Serve others like Christ who stooped down to wash the feet of his disciples (Jn 13:5)

Christian freedom should liberate us from our comfort zone / complacency to launch into the deep to build bridges by demolishing the outmoded practices of hostility and revengeful attitudes. The main role of the host family is to provide a safe, welcoming environment with which the student feels at home, supported, and encouraged to participate in family life, learn the Canadian lifestyle and acquire language skills. The ride can either be by car or with a provided bus pass (within a 45minute ride from the school). In exchange, the family is reimbursed \$1000 / month per student.
