PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord Jesus!

"Jesus, a tragic Hero!" seems to be the message we get out of this week's scriptures. Hero is someone of high standing with impeccable character and an insignificant flaw in life. Some are born great, some become great by their nobility of heart and some are made great by popular acclamation. We read in our historical records about our heroes and heroines. But Jesus became a Hero because of his "Love & Mercy". This was the only flaw he had in life and that became fatal in his life. People consider this as a simple failure in life which caused his life. But that's what Jesus is all about who wished for an ambitious world transformation in a non-violent way through his Love & Mercy.

Shakespeare, the world-famous playwright explains the Tragedy of the Hero in "Julius Caesar and Macbeth: "Because of the flaw in his character, he underwent problems which cast his life. Though flaw is a minor and insignificant element, it leads him to a greater and fatal incident. Jesus was carried away by 'mercy and compassion' the non-violent gesture, which brought about his tragic fall as a human being. To have a flaw in life indeed is common and natural. That's what makes us humans. But people take advantage of it and magnify the situation, which brings about their downfall. Jesus was commissioned by God the Father to give expression to this ideal of Love and Mercy, and Jesus gave up his life for this ideal.' He loved us to the end', writes St. John.

The falling of the Hero from his or her high estate to a tragic death is called the 'Reversal of Fortune', by the playwrights. We admire each character in these events. But we are reminded of our own fidelity to Christ as we reflect these wonderful scriptures today.

How do we react to our own reversal of fortunes, especially from happiness to sadness, from health to sickness or from life to death? What is my weakness that could make me strong and strengthened before Christ? St. Paul reminds us, "When we are weak, then we become strong, because the power of Jesus makes us so" (2 Cor 12:10) May the good Lord help us with a clear mind and conscience to participate in His Life-giving suffering and death in the coming days of grace.

## ST. KATERI TEKAKWITHA RETREAT

Celebrate with us the feast day of St. Kateri Tekakwitha (1656-1680), also known as Lily of the Mohawks, the first Indigenous saint of North America. St. Kateri converted to Catholicism at age 19 and, after refusing to marry, moved to the Jesuit mission at Kahnawake, south of Montreal. There, she lived a life of prayer and asceticism. Following her death, many miracles and supernatural occurrences were attributed to her. She was canonized in 2012. In Canada, her feast is celebrated April 17.




