PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

The Salutation of the Eucharistic Liturgy succinctly explains the mystery of the Holy Trinity: "The Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the Love of God and the Fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all." Trinity is ONE. We do not confess three Gods, but One God in Three Persons. Each has their Divine Substance, Essence and Nature. The divine persons are really distinct from one another. God is ONE. Father, Son and the Holy Spirit are not simply names but they are distinct from one another in their relations of origin. It is the Father who Generates, the Son who is Begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds. Therefore, the Divine Unity is Triune.

Pope Benedict XVI explained in 2021 in Milan during the World Family Conference that the Trinity should be the model of our Family Life & Love. Families are based on Trinitarian Love. Families have shared love, Unity and Deep Relationships. Love is Steadfast and Mutual. It is reciprocal and unconditional.

Pope John Paul II explained, Family Love should be 'Genuine & Authentic. There should be no artificiality in True Love. Family Unity is remarkable. In families' persons are united to each other, though individuals but they are bonded together with us. We are in need of each other. Therefore, relationships are important. Otherwise, we become 'inhuman' and we live in exclusion and die in isolation from others. We are made for each other. The DNA of human beings is 'Relationship'.

Karl Rahner the great Theologian explained from the Book of Genesis 1:26-27 "God Created humans in His image and likeness." So, humans are made in the image and likeness of God.

If God is Community of persons in a relationship of Self-giving love - Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, then it makes sense to imagine that, we as human beings, who are made in God's image and likeness are 'hard-wired' to be in relationship with God, with each other and with the entire cosmos.

The Catechism asks this question: "Why did God make me?" The answer: "God made me to know, love and serve God in this life so that I can live in happiness with God forever." Therefore, our goal should be to share in the very life of the trinity by our deep relationship with the family in which we live. As humans, we are social beings. Sometimes being alone is even a form of Torture (Solitary confinement)

The Father, Son and the Holy Spirit have been engaged in our lives, since our Baptism and we are theirs. During this week, let us particularly be attentive to the presence of God. Share our goodwill with others. Remain in communion with everyone in charity. Tolerate the differences. Share our gifts, talents and resources together. As a Parish let us welcome all, recognize each other, appreciate the skills and special talents of everyone. Let us support one another in the Bond of Charity. Let us grow and 'Bear Fruit' in and through Christian life & love.




