Book of the Living / Book of Remembrance!

This expression 'Book of Life' comes from Psalm 69:28 and the names of the just/virtuous are written in this book. Psalm 139:16 explains, "You had scrutinized every action and all were recorded in your book"

Christianity and Judaism consider the Book of Life as a Heavenly Record, in which God records the Names of every person who is destined for Heaven. "Those who prove victorious will be dressed in white robes. Their names will not be blot out from the Book of Life, but will be remembered in the Presence of my Father & Angels"(Rev3:5) Luke 10:20 encourages the believers, 'to rejoice because your names are written in Heaven'.
