Feast of Christ the King!

"Let us have a king to rule us" (1Samuel 8:7) The Israelites requested Prophet Samuel to give them a King for an effective leadership to meet the challenges of their times. When Samuel reflected the request for a King, he understood their wish to emulate other neighbouring nations but upset with their 'Rejection of the Rule of God' (They have rejected me from being king over them) Samuel anointed Saul as their first king and David succeeded to rule the Israelites after.

Several Fairy Tales speak about the kings & queens inviting their readers to imitate them. Some of the stories of the royals are even today fantastic and others are so revengeful. I read a few like Helen of Troy, King Lear & Julius Caesar. They are wonderful with the twists and turns but they had a great sense of humour creating an atmosphere of adventure.

Kings, Queens, Emperors, the present PM & Presidents of several of our countries represent the Divine Authority of governance for providing safety & security to their citizens. But the Two Great World Wars of our modern era just went crazy from this noble ideal and paved the way to the theory of 'might is right'. The untold chaos and the turmoil it caused still lingers in the life and existence of the sufferers and the makers of war.

In order to give a "Role Model of Governance & Authority' to the modern leaders, Pope Pius XI in 1925 established this Feast of Christ the King. The world had undergone a great tragedy because of the greed of the power-hungry politicians and their associates. Pope Pius helped them to follow the 'Rule of Justice, Peace & Humanity" (Rm14.17)



Help this shepherd to spot the goats in his flock. Circle them.


