Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

Widows and Widowers are front and centre in our readings this week. They are oftentimes silent people but very involved in our parish and community life & activities. Mark 12:44 was worth remembering: "She has given everything that she had for her living". (Such people sacrifice everything that might sustain & provide for their life and existence. Their self-offering including their wealth and welfare were highly appreciated by Jesus) In fact they begin to depend on God alone. The Widow's offering caught the sight of Jesus because she was very discreet and did not make any noise/ fanfare about her offering. Her donation to the temple was very small/too little. It was insignificant & worthless to be mentioned. But she had the great honour from God himself. We are reminded of our Human Calculations and God's Standards when we reflect these passages of the Scriptures today.

"God looks at our hearts & intentions whereas humans look at our external appearances". (1Sm 16:7 & Lk 16:15) The widow solely depended on the goodness of God for everything and not on her surplus or leftovers. Her meager donation was highly appreciated by God to give us a lasting lesson that we need to do our part willingly and cheerfully. This is 'Divine Logic' and the appreciation of the Divine for the widow overturns the human way of thinking. The wealthy contributed for the favor of the Emperor. Whereas this poor widow for the glory of God, out of her poverty contributed in her humility of heart and not for the praise of the Emperor. She emptied herself as Jesus emptied himself (Phil 2:6-12) She made a complete self-offering through her self-sacrificing offering like Jesus, who volunteered to die for the rest of humankind. Therefore, God highly exalted Jesus and made him Lord and Savior of the World.

This week's Scriptures in fact speak about our 'piety'. (External expressions of religiosity are not necessarily a sign of Real Piety) 'Real Piety is the Gift of God/ Gift of the Holy Spirit'. Real Piety is rooted in the Love of God, like the love of children for their parents, which is at the heart of real piety, the gift of the Holy Spirit. Of course, it is difficult for us to know whether external expressions of Spirituality really flow from this love - but it is God's place, and not ours, to make that judgement. It's enough for us to heed Jesus' warning to beware and not assume that what we see externally is always the full story. We should ask God to send His Spirit so that the way we live our faith is truly a fruit of the gift of piety which we received in Baptism & Confirmation. May the good Lord help us.


