**PASTOR'S MESSAGE** 

Memory of our Deceased Loved ones! Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ!

November is a Sacred month dedicated for the solemn memory of our Deceased loved ones. Sooner or later we would be joining this illustrious company of the lovers of Christ in Heaven, our Homeland & Paradise. Psalm 90:9-10 explains our present condition, "Our days dwindle under your watch. Our lives are over in a Breath. Our life lasts for Seventy years or eighty with Good health" Mathew cautions in 15:1-13 "Stay awake, because you do not know either the day or the hour" The living humans are advised by the Scriptures to engage in honorable pursuits so that the Lord may grant us Eternal Rest when He calls us to be with Him. 'Death is like a thief in the night' reminds St. Paul.
