PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers & Sisters in the Lord!

'Favor of God' is the pleasant topic for this Weekend. 'Favor' is being understood as a blessing. It may be wealth, property, status, prestige, privilege or honor, being generous and gentle, being trustworthy and committed & etc. Scriptures tell us, "In prosperity, let us be grateful. In adversity let us be thankful". Material wealth is a blessing. It helps us achieve selfreliance and to live in our comfort zone. Sometimes excessive wealth leads to 'Spiritual Complacency' which is often times manifested in inordinate & inconsiderate behaviour especially so in one's arrogant activities. Such people depend more on their material wealth than on the Providence of God.

Wealth and Power are good. But when they are excessive, false security is being generated in human life. Therefore today, the scriptures recommend to 'imbibe the attitude of gratitude' and the capacity to share what we have with others in order to gain 'Eternal Life'. St. John 17:3 tells us, "Eternal life is to know you the True God, and know Christ, whom you sent". Eternal Life is a blessing of God. A favor or benevolence from the Almighty. It flows from 'right living'. Material goods should be prudently used to inherit this blessing. Jesus does not denounce material possessions. He only cautions our excessive attachment to them (Mt 6:24)

The Book of Deuteronomy 14:22 talks about 'tithes' which is, sharing a portion of our income for the care of the poor or the missions. People in North America Contribute enormous amounts of money and wealth for the support and upkeep of the Church in Mission Territories. The Church with its profound gratitude appreciates and honors their 'Noble Gesture of

Goodwill'. Their detachment is a willful self-denial for a greater good. Pope Francis laments about the 'stock markets' now and then in his speeches. According to him, "Stock markets make headline news - whereas the poor of the world, the refugees, the exiled of God's children do not come to the forefront in the News Media". 'We are in a way, living in a throw away culture' laments the Pope.

Money can buy a variety of food stuff, but not a peaceable heart to savor its taste. Money can buy a cozy bed, but it cannot facilitate a comfortable sleep. Money can buy an expensive car/motorhome/boat & etc., but not a smooth ride or drive or a great living. Money can buy wonderful World Classic Books/Videos/Sceneries, but it cannot bless one with Wisdom. It's, like the Millionaires and Billionaires living in boats. It is not lasting. Therefore, the Scriptures today extend an invitation to 'Seek first the kingdom of God' and the rest will be granted to those who search for it diligently. It's worth remembering Romans 14:17 "The Kingdom of God is not food and drink. But it is Peace, Joy and Justice in the Holy Spirit". May the good Lord help us to be mindful of our future glory in Heaven!

21 years ago, two Irish Jesuits were quick to appreciate the potential of the Internet as a force for digital evangelization when they started a website as a Lenten experiment in offering guided prayer online.

The experiment extended far beyond Lent, going from strength to strength. Today, the global phenomenon that is "Sacred Space" is among the top most-visited prayer websites in the world. It attracts 18,000 visitors <u>a</u> day, of all Christian faiths and none from around the globe, praying at their computers, on their laptops, tablets or smartphones, in 22 languages. The site guides the visitor through a session of prayer, in six stages, including preparing your body and mind, and culminating in reflection on a scripture passage chosen specially for the day. Statement of Apology by the Catholic Bishop of Canada to the Indigenous Peoples of this Land:

The Catholic Bishops of Canada, gathered in Plenary this week, took the opportunity to affirm and acknowledge to the Indigenous Peoples the suffering experienced in Canada's Indian Residential Schools. Many Catholic religious communities and dioceses participated in this system, which led to the suppression of Indigenous languages, culture and spirituality, failing to respect the rich history, traditions and wisdom of Indigenous Peoples. They acknowledged the grave abuses that were committed by some members of our Catholic community; physical, psychological, emotional, spiritual, cultural, and sexual. They also sorrowfully acknowledged the historical and ongoing trauma and the legacy of suffering and challenges faced by Indigenous Peoples that continue to this day. Along with those Catholic entities which were directly involved in the operation of the schools and which have already offered their own heartfelt apologies, the Catholic Bishops of Canada expressed their profound remorse and apologized unequivocally. Together with the many pastoral initiatives already underway in dioceses across the country, the Bishops pledged to undertake fundraising in each region of the country to support initiatives discerned locally with Indigenous partners. Furthermore, they invited the Indigenous Peoples to journey with us into a new era of reconciliation, helping us to prioritize initiatives of healing, to listen to the experience of Indigenous Peoples, especially to the survivors of Indian Residential Schools, and to educate our clergy, consecrated men and women, and lay faithful, on Indigenous cultures and spirituality. They further committed to continue the work of providing documentation or records that will assist in the memorialization of those buried in unmarked graves. A delegation of Indigenous survivors, Elders/knowledge keepers, and youth will meet with the Holy Father in December 2021. Pope Francis will encounter and listen to the Indigenous Peoples, so as to discern how he can support our common desire to renew relationships and walk together along the path of hope in the coming years. The Bishops of Canada have pledged to work with the Holy See and our Indigenous partners on the possibility of a pastoral visit by the Pope to Canada as part of this healing journey. We are committed to continue the journey with the First Nations, Métis and Inuit Peoples of this land. For more information, please contact the diocese or visit www.cccb.ca.
